20	("Agreement") to rehabilitate the Guadalupe Street Bridge; and
21	WHEREAS, Section 19 allows for modification of the Agreement by an instrument in
22	writing executed by the parties; and
23	WHEREAS, Section 4.g requires the Governing Body to adopt a written resolution of
24	project support that includes commitment to funding, ownership, liability and maintenance; and
25	WHEREAS, the City and the NMDOT have agreed to extend the term of the Agreement

to combine the bridge rehabilitation project with S100360 Guadalupe Street Reconstruction Road
Diet Project to save construction funds and cut traffic delays to the public; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Santa Fe accepts responsibility for the Project; assumes the lead role in design development and construction of the Project; agrees to the terms, conditions, and certification and reporting requirements of the Agreement; and assumes ownership, liability, and maintenance responsibilities for all amenities related to the completion of the Project.
