## **December 11, 2015**

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the City of Santa Fe Capital Improvements Advisory Committee was called to order by Jack Hiatt at 3:05 p.m. on this date in the City Councilors' Conference Room, 1st Floor, City Hall, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

## 2. ROLL CALL

Roll call indicated a quorum was present as follows:

#### 3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The agenda was amended: Action Item 6A (Public Works Department Request) was moved up after Approval of the Minutes.

Mr. Shanahan moved to approve the Agenda as amended. Ms. Veneklasen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

• Meeting of October 8, 2015

The following change was made to the Minutes of the October 8, 2015 meeting: Page 7, last paragraph, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lines were changed to read: "For the suspension period (01-23-2012 to 01-22-2014), the City collected \$798,156 in commercial impact fees and did not collect \$1,656,707 in residential impact fees. For the 50% Reduction Period (02-27-2014 to 08-31-2015), the City collected \$1,518,550 in total impact fees and did not collect \$452,620 in residential impact fees.

Ms. Van Peski moved to approve the Minutes of the October 8, 2015 meeting as amended. Mr. Shanahan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 5. MATTERS FROM THE CHAIR

Chair Walker was absent, therefore there were no matters from the Chair.

## 6. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

A. Public Works Department – Request to use Impact Fees (PWD Staff)

Cerrillos Road (Phase IIC) - Request \$318,493.18 from the Road Impact

Fee Account

(Copies of the Memo from John Romero dated November 18, 2015 was distributed in the Members' packets. A copy is hereby incorporated to these Minutes as Exhibit "6A".)

Mr. Liming introduced John Romero, the Engineering Division Director.

Mr. Romero presented the request from the Public Works Department.

## **Background & Summary:**

The City of Santa Fe Public Works Department issued a request for bids on October 13, 2015 for project construction. Three bids were received on November 10, 2015. The lowest qualified bidder is AUI, Inc. of Albuquerque with a bid amount of \$8,799,347.76 exclusive of New Mexico Gross Receipts Tax. Funds required for construction, including tax, contingency and construction management, totals \$10,700,000. Currently, City, Federal and State funds in the amount of \$10,381,506.82 are available for project construction. Additional funds in the amount of \$318,493.18 are required to award a construction contract and to provide adequate construction management. It is recommended that \$318,493.18 in impact fees are utilized to fully fund project construction. The project is identified in the Impact Fees Capital Improvement Plan 2020 for Planned Major Road Improvements Plan.

The Public Works Department requested the following:

Support the use of Impact Fee funds in the amount of \$318,493.18 to fund construction of CIP #810A – Cerrillos Road Reconstruction Project, Phase IIC- Camino Carlos Rey to Llano Street.

## **Discussion/Questions/Comments:**

Ms. Van Peski asked who gets the construction management money.

Mr. Romero said the money will go to the consultant of the design company (Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc.). They will need to amend their contract and the proposed amendment is going through the committee process and was approved by the Public Works Committee this past Monday. It will go before the Finance Committee and City Council next.

Copies of the printout of the project were reviewed.

Mr. Martinez asked if the project is ADA compliant.

Mr. Romero said the project was reviewed by the City's ADA representative, as well as the New Mexico Department of Transportation ADA representative.

Mr. Shanahan asked if this was the last and final phase for the Cerrillos Project.

Mr. Romero said yes, this is the last phase of the three phases of the project - due to funding constraints. However, he hopes the last portion of the project (potential drainage improvements) will be constructed and funded in the future.

Mr. Liming asked what the anticipated timeframe is for the project.

Mr. Romero said they are anticipating to award the contract in mid-January and give a Notice to Proceed in March. He noted that PNM has to relocate some street lights and the contract will allow further coordination of those efforts. He mentioned that the calendar substantial completion date is October of 2016. The physical completion date is not until May of the following year because they have to wait to put the final pavement and striping until the weather is warmer.

Ms. Van Peski moved to approve the request to use/allocate Impact Fees (from the Roads Impact Fee Account) in the amount of \$318,493.18 for construction of the Cerrillos Road Reconstruction Project, Phase IIC- Camino Carlos Rey to Llano Street. Mr. Shanahan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 7. INFORMATION ITEMS

There were no informational items.

#### 8. MATTERS FROM THE COMMITTEE / STAFF

Mr. Shanahan asked Mr. Liming if anybody is moving forward on the Committee's recommendation (with regard to the reduction of the residential impact fees to 50% and the commercial impact fees to 50%).

Mr. Liming said no, not that he knows of.

#### 9. MATTERS FROM THE FLOOR

There were no matters from the Floor.

## 10. NEXT QUARTERLY MEETING DATE:

The next quarterly meeting is scheduled for January 14, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.

## 11. ADJOURNMENT
