Item and Issue:

Request for acceptance of the FY 2016-17 Law Enforcement Protection Fund (LEPF) Funds Application. Fund 2211, Business Unit 21211.

Background and Summary:

Attached is the LEPF Fund Application for FY 2016-17 in the amount of \$126,600. This is a State of New Mexico funded distribution for municipal and county law enforcement agencies in New Mexico.

The Santa Fe Police Department falls within Class 2 funding based on population per the 2010 Census. Class 2 entitles the SFPD to receive \$30,000 as a base, and funds \$600 per *certified* Police Officer. Currently the Police Department employs 161 certified Police Officers, expected at July 1, 2016, resulting in additional funding of \$96,600.

The funds guidelines allow for expenses associated with advanced training and the repair and purchase of law enforcement apparatus, equipment, and supplies.

This distribution requires no match from City funds. **There is a deadline, however, which requires the completed and approved funds application to be submitted to the State of New Mexico Department of Finance, Local Government Division by March 31, 2016** for their consideration and review.
