Santa Fe Bike Share Up-Date

Downtown Albuquerque and the Mid-Region Council of Governments are awaiting official confirmation from PNM regarding financial assistance for the expansion of their existing bike-share program for 2016.

In anticipation of an expansion that includes Santa Fe, the need for continued fund raising and acquiring the necessary permitting for 4 initial sites the Santa Fe MPO is seeking support from the BTAC for the execution of a small pilot project to begin late spring of 2016. This pilot project will initially consist of four stations with five bicycles at each station provided by the Zagster Bike-Share Inc, in accordance to the terms and agreements set forth between Zagster and Downtown ABQ. Additional sites may become operational if future funding is secured.

Initial station sites include the following:

1. Downtown Santa Fe: NE Corner of Grant and Palace, Sponsorship – Santa Fe County Economic Development
2. New Solana Center Parking Lot: 913 W. Alameda, Sponsorship – NMEMNRD
3. Santa Fe Railyard: Manhattan Ave & Rail trail, Sponsorship – Pending
4. South Capital Station: Near existing bus/train stops, Sponsorship – Pending

If funding is secured for the initial pilot project, the Santa Fe MPO will continue to work closely with Downtown ABQ and the Mid-Region Council of Governments with elements of implementation, monitoring and reporting that includes memberships, ridership, and destination and duration data.
