


What is the future of the aging services network as we know it? On the 50th anniversary of the Older Americans Act, we are at a crossroads. Aging services are changing with the expansion of managed care, increased demand and flat or reduced federal and state funding. How does the aging network manage through this transitional period? Does it emerge stronger or does become obsolete? These and other issues, including the emerging field of elder justice, will be discussed.



Directions

From the North:

Take I-25 until you reach Exit 215 (which is the exit onto Broadway SE and NE). Select the left lane as you loop onto Broadway SE. Two stoplights later, you will arrive at the Isleta Resort & Casino.

From the South:

Take I-25 until you see the sign for the hotel which is Exit 215. Immediately exit and veer to the right onto State Road 47. Two stoplights later, you will arrive at the Isleta Resort & Casino.

From the East or West:

Take I-40 to the I-25 Interchange Exit 159-B. You will now be going south. Proceed on I-25 until you reach Exit 215 which is the exit onto Broadway SE and NE. Select the left lane as you loop onto Broadway SE. Two stoplights later you will arrive at the Isleta Resort & Casino.

A Rail Runner Station is located across the street from the Isleta Resort & Casino. A complimentary shuttle is available.




