

**Request to Transfer Inter-Local Liquor License: 3251 Cerrillos Road
Analysis of Detrimental Impact on Public Health, Safety or Morals
For Public Hearing: December 9, 2015**

1. Public Health Conditions: EMS Calls

In the past four years, this address has been one of the top 12 addresses for EMS calls; in 3 out of 4 years, this address has been in the top 10.

2. Public Safety Conditions: SFPD Calls for Service

In the past two years, there have been this address has been one of the top 12 addresses for EMS calls; in 3 out of 4 years, this address has been in the top 10.

3. Traffic Safety Conditions: NM Department of Transportation

In 2013, this location was identified as being in a Medium Density area for Alcohol-Involved Crashes, immediately adjacent to a High Density area. 9 Alcohol-Involved Crashes occurred near the location.

4. Location: Proximity to sensitive locations, such as transitional housing, social service agencies, schools, etc.

The proposed location is immediately adjacent to a number of multi-unit housing complexes where residents report significant problems including public intoxication, drug activity, domestic violence/child abuse, gang activity, prostitution, etc. In addition several social services agencies serving vulnerable populations are located nearby, including: Esperanza offices, the Interfaith Shelter, Friendship Club and Life Link

5. Location: Proximity to other establishments that sell liquor (clustering)

There are **4 establishments** with liquor licenses to sell packaged liquor near the proposed location (see attached map and listing).

Per your request, here are some City of Santa Fe Fire Department statistics.

Historical requests for Emergency Medical Services at 3251 Cerrillos Road are as follows:

- 2012: 43 responses (8th most frequently responded-to address in the City);
- 2013: 48 responses (8th most frequently responded-to address in the City);
- 2014: 41 responses (12th most frequently responded-to address in the City);
- 2015 (YTD): 44 responses (9th most frequently responded-to address in the City).

Types of locations in the top 10 most frequently responded-to addresses in the City:

- Homeless Shelter;
- Santa Fe Place Mall;
- Ski Basin;
- Urgent Care Center;
- Skilled Nursing Facilities;
- Multi-family Apartments;
- Personal Residences.

 - 2013: 996 (9.3%)
 - 2014: 878 (8.6%)

 - 2013: 877 (8.2%)
 - 2014: 819 (8.1%)
 - 2015: 562 (6.2%)


