ITEM & ISSUE:

SIRINGO BICYCLE FACILITIES BETWEEN ST FRANCIS AND BOTULPH

BACKGROUND & SUMMARY:

The Bicycle and Trails Advisory Committee (BTAC) has asked city staff to look at the possibility of placing bicycle lanes along Siringo. The Public Works Department has presented plans to BTAC that will introduce bike lanes on the majority of Siringo from Yucca to Botulph.

BTAC directed staff to work with the On-Road subcommittee to determine the appropriate bicycle markings on Siringo between St Francis Drive and Botulph. In accordance with this, staff conducted a site visit with the On-Road Subcommittee on June 27, 2016. At this meeting, staff explained the necessity of maintaining parking along Siringo between Miguel Chavez Road and Botulph as it is highly utilized during school activities at St Michaels High School. We also discussed the applicability of Sharrows in this area. At this meeting, it was agreed that no Sharrows be placed and that the City add additional "Share the Road" signs.
