

ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COMMITTEE
(Subcommittee of Arts Commission)

PURPOSE: Established per the Art in Public Places Ordinance, this committee oversees the purchase, commission and donation of work that becomes a part of the City's public art collection.

MEMBERSHIP: The Art in Public Places committee is a seven-member advisory group appointed by the Arts Commission. The committee generally consists of an Arts Commissioner, community representative, art historian, visual artist, sculptor, art professional such as a curator, critic or art historian and architect, landscape architect or urban planner.

TERMS: Each committee member is appointed to a four year term which is renewable once.
