

## **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**

**CREATING AUTHORITY:** Adopted by the Governing Body on November 13, 1974. Amended on March 28, 1984 by Ordinance No. 1984-19 (Name Change from Community Development Commission to Community Development Board, in accordance with Section 3-60-35 NMSA 1978). Amended on January 14, 1998 by Ordinance No. 1998-3 (Name Change from Community Development Board to Community Development Commission)

**MEMBERS:** The Mayor, with the consent of the City Council shall appoint seven (7) commissioners to the commission. Of the original appointees, two (2) commissioners shall serve terms of one (1) year; two (2) shall serve terms of two (2) years; and three (3) shall serve terms of three (3) years; thereafter, commissioners shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years. Commissioners may be removed with or without cause at any time by the Mayor. The Mayor shall designate a chairman and vice-chairman from among the commissioners.

### **POWERS AND DUTIES:**

The commission shall advise the governing body of the city in:

- A. Administration of the community development block grant program in accordance with the city's adopted consolidated plan;
- B. Administration of the Santa Fe Homes Program in accordance with adopted ordinances and administrative guidelines.
- C. Establishing a general plan for the city relating to economic and other community development issues.
- D. Allocating loans according to the Affordable Housing Investment Loan Fund Ordinance as set forth in Section 11-16 SFCC 1987.
