NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe will hold a public hearing at their regular City Council Meeting on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 200 Lincoln Avenue.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to consider the following:

- 1) Bill No. 2015-15: An Ordinance Relating to the Land Development Code, Chapter 14 SFCC 1987; Amending Subsection 14-6.1(C), Table 14-6.1-1, Table Of Allowed Uses To Correct Typographic Errors in the Designations of Districts Within Which Sheltered Care Facilities are Permitted, and Making Such Other Stylistic or Grammatical Changes That Are Necessary.
- 2) Bill No. 2015-16: An Ordinance Amending the City of Santa Fe Alarm System Ordinance, Section 20-5 SFCC 1987 to Clarify Certain Provisions; Amend the Fines for False Alarms; and Amend Late Reporting Fees That Are Assessed Against Alarm Installation Companies and Alarm Monitoring Companies.
- 3) Bill No. 2015-17: An Ordinance Creating a New Section 7-16 SFCC 1987 to Require That Single-Occupant Public or Employee Restrooms in Any Commercial Facility be Gender Neutral and Identified as Such by Appropriate Signage.
- 4) Bill No. 2015-18: An Ordinance Amending Section 12-6-1.3 of the City of Santa Fe Uniform Traffic Ordinance to Authorize the Governing Body to Make Speed Limit Alterations in the City of Santa Fe through the Adoption of a Resolution.


