POWERS AND DUTIES:

Shall provide continuing oversight of the operations of the city's water, wastewater and solid waste collection and disposal utilities, study and solicit public comment and make recommendations to the governing body concerning annual operating budgets, capital improvements, the issuance of debt instruments, operational policies, procedures, rules and regulations, franchise agreements, for gas, electricity, telephone and other utilities, and utility service rates and fees based on sound business principles, wise stewardship of natural resources and in accordance with revenue requirements that may be established through bond covenants.
