

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
(Standing)

CREATING AUTHORITY: Adopted on May 10, 2000 by Resolution 2000-33.

MEMBERS: The Public Safety Committee shall consist of nine members. Membership of the committee shall consist of a chairperson who shall be a member of the governing body, a vice chair who shall be a citizen at large, and seven other at large members.

TERM: The term of each member shall be four years. Members need not be residents of the City of Santa Fe.

CHAIRMAN: The Mayor shall appoint a member of the Governing Body as the chair and the vice chair shall be designated by the chair in accordance with Article 8.

MEETING TIMES: 4th Tuesday, Monthly, 4:00 p.m.

PURPOSE:

The Public Safety Committee shall be charged with reviewing programs, initiatives, projects, construction, signage and such other matters regarding the Santa Fe Police and Fire Departments operations as may require public examination prior to Governing Body approval. The Public Safety Committee shall also be charged with making recommendations to the Finance Committee, Governing Body and such other bodies as may be required to consider public safety issues.
