Re: Response to Complaint by Tarin Nix

This response addresses the complaint filed by Tarin Nix on November 25, 2013 and served on December 3. Candidate Bushee requests that the complaint be dismissed as a matter of law because it fails to state a violation of city code.

9-3.6 Seed Money Contributions

The complaint alleges that Candidate Bushee made an improper "contribution" to her campaign's seed money account and an improper expenditure to Ms. Nix. This is a mischaracterization both of the intent and purpose of Candidate Bushee's personal advance of funds directly to Ms. Nix, at Ms. Nix' own insistence, before the decision to seek public financing and also of Bushee's efforts to comply with the code requirements thereafter.

A. The payment to Ms. Nix was not an improper seed money contribution or expenditure

Candidate Bushee's original payment to Ms. Nix was not a seed money contribution, as defined by Section 9-3.3(M), nor was it meant to be. It was not paid out of the seed money account as was the later conforming payment. Candidate Bushee did not deposit personal funds in the seed money account and then pay Ms. Nix back out of those funds. Rather, the advance payment was a stopgap measure to address Ms. Nix' demand for payment upon her departure from the campaign. Nor was the payment an "expenditure" under the definition of Section 9-3.3(E)(1). The definition does not include payment made by candidate individually before certification.

B. The Code does not address this situation

The Code does not address the mechanics of paying costs which thereafter are legitimately subject to payment from a seed money account, but which are required to be paid prior¹ to receipt of adequate seed money funding.

Section 9-3.11(D), the substantive limitation on nonpublic expenditures, does address the restricted time period: "a candidate who has been certified as a participating candidate shall not thereafter accept any contribution to the candidate's campaign other than payments received from the fund... and shall not make any expenditure in support of the candidate's campaign from any source other than payments so received and previously

¹ It should be noted that it was Ms. Nix' own demand for payment that caused the situation; had she waited for payment there would be no issue. Moreover, it was her decision not to return the initial payment, but rather to get paid twice for the same work, that created the situation that she complains about.

deposited in the candidate's campaign depository." Thus, the code limits contributions and expenditures by candidates *after* certification, but not *before*.

In short, there is simply no seed money contribution, no expenditure, and hence no violation. The complaint poses a novel situation that the Code does not address and does not proscribe.

The Board may wish to recommend to the Governing Body appropriate Code amendments to clarify the proper course governing such an unclear situation. Instead pursuant to Section 6-16.2(H), but because there is no Code violation the Board has no jurisdiction to take any action on the complaint other than dismissal.

9-3.8 Application for Certification

The complaint asserts Candidate Bushee "is in violation of the statement that the candidate has made no expenditures from any source other than seed money contributions." However Ms. Nix was fully paid from the seed money account prior to the affirmation.

The November 16 application states "I affirm that I have not made any expenditures for my current campaign from any source other than seed money contributions." Complaint Exhibit 4 is a November 15, 2013 check from the "Patti for Mayor" account to Nix for \$1,750. Ms. Nix does not claim to have done more than \$1,750 worth of work, despite her retention of double payment. Therefore, full payment was tendered, out of the seed money account, prior to the date of the affirmation.


Ms. Nix demanded payment before the seed money account was funded and before the decision to use public financing. Under those unique circumstances, Candidate Bushee had no option but to advance those funds personally, and did so in an attempt to be fair to Ms. Nix. After subsequent proper payment from the seed account Ms. Nix was requested to return the original advance in the same spirit of fairness. She declined to do so, but regardless of the windfall to her, the fact is that she was fully paid out of the campaign seed money account.

The complaint fails on its face to state a violation of the code. Even if there were any technical violation within the Board's jurisdiction to address, it is not ongoing and even at that only the result of Candidate Bushee's good faith effort to comply with the intent of the public finance system under circumstances that the Code does not address. Moreover, the remedial action was taken after consultation with the independent Common Cause of New Mexico as to how to best proceed. Considering (i) the absence of any regulations prohibiting such a cure and (ii) the absence of any evidence that Candidate Bushee attempted to circumvent the regulations, dismissal as a matter of law is consistent with the public policy goal of the Code to *encourage* Public financing method in mayoral campaigns


Candidate Bushee waives an evidentiary hearing in accordance with SFCC 6-16.7(E) and asserts that because there are no material facts in dispute the Board should consider the issue as a matter of course.

APPENDIX
RELEVANT DEFINITIONS

9-3.3 Definitions.

As used in this section, the following terms have the following meanings:

E. *Contribution* means a loan, loan guarantee, gift, advance, pledge, contract, agreement or promise of money or anything of value or other obligation, whether or not legally enforceable, made directly or indirectly, to a candidate or political committee for the purpose of influencing the outcome of a municipal election.

- (1) The term "contribution" includes:
 - (a) The transfer of funds or anything of value between political committees;
 - (b) The transfer of anything of value for less than full consideration;
 - (c) Interest, dividends or other income derived from the investment of campaign funds;
 - (d) The payment for the services of an individual serving on behalf of a candidate or political committee, which payments are made by a third party; and
 - (e) The purchase of tickets for fundraising events such as dinners, rallies, raffles, etc. and the proceeds of collections at fundraising events.

G. *Expenditure* means a payment or transfer of anything of value in exchange for goods, services, property, facilities or anything of value for the purpose of assisting, benefiting or honoring any public official or candidate, or assisting in furthering or opposing any election campaign for a candidate or ballot proposition. This includes contributions, subscriptions, distributions, loans, advances, deposits, or gifts of money or anything of value, and includes a contract, a promise or agreement, whether or not legally enforceable, to make an expenditure. The term "expenditure" also means the transfer of funds or anything of value between political committees. In determining the dollar value of an expenditure, only that proportion of a payment or transfer of anything of value that is directly related to the campaign shall be considered an expenditure.



The nature of the alleged violations are enumerated in paragraph 3 below. I am referencing the Election and Political Campaign Codes, specifically 9-3 Public Campaign Finance Code.

My complaints (as supported by my reference to the Code in paragraph 3 of the Complaint Form) are that there have been false and inaccurate statements made by Patti Bushee and the Bushee Mayoral Campaign regarding her request for public campaign finance funding. Ms. Bushee began her campaign as a privately-funded campaign, and after that effort was unsuccessful, attempted to seek public campaign funding. I believe this has violated the Public Campaign Finance Code by obtaining seed money contributions in excess of the amount allowed (\$100). By her own admission, Ms. Bushee contributed \$1,750 of her own money, which violates the \$100 contribution limit. She has also maintained that she has reported \$6,000 of seed money contributions, but Ms. Bushee did not disclose the payment to me in June, which would put her over the \$6,000 limit.

Seed money contributions, as I understand it, "shall be used only for the purpose of seeking to become a participating candidate and accept seed money contributions to defray expenses incurred in obtaining qualified contributions in seeking certification as a participating candidate." The \$1,750 which Ms. Bushee paid to me, were as a campaign manager and was not spent pursuant to 9-3.6 A.

Ms. Bushee also failed to report her contribution to her campaign and payment to me of \$1,750 in her affidavit seeking public finance funds. She also is in violation of the statement that the candidate has made no expenditures from any source other than seed money contributions. Again, as noted at Section 9-3.8, Sub-Section B, 2 and 3. I rely on the citations in paragraph 3, but I wanted to state in my words, my understanding of the violations of the Public Finance Code.

By way of supporting background, I will say that on May 14, I was solicited by Patti Bushee, via telephone, while living in Austin, TX. She asked me to make a trip out to Santa Fe to interview for the position of Campaign Manager. During which time, she stated that she was interested in running a private, well-funded campaign. On Memorial Day weekend, I ventured out to Santa Fe to meet with Patti Bushee, Walt Borton and Joe Lennihan at Babaluus Cuban Restaurant on May 25. We had a two hour long conversation, in which we discussed campaign strategy, my monthly income of \$3,500 and the need to raise anywhere from \$120,000 to \$160,000 to be successful. At the end of the dinner, Patti Bushee agreed to hire me as Campaign Manager, which is also noted in email correspondence on the same date, attached hereto as Exhibit No.2.

I drove back to Texas the next day and began packing up my belongings, quit my full time job and by June 1, had relocated myself back to Santa Fe, to officially start as campaign manager on the Bushee Mayoral Campaign. During my time on the campaign, I attend numerous team and individual meetings on behalf of the campaign. I also assisted with website development, talking points/campaign messaging and created a summer campaign plan, attached hereto as Exhibit No. 2.



After nearly a month of service, I was informed by Ms. Bushee and her campaign associates, Walt Borton and Joe Lennihan, that because the private fundraising was not going as well as they had hoped, they wanted to revisit the idea of running a publicly funded campaign. They asked me at that point if I would take a reduction in pay. After a brief discussion, I indicated I would not. I was thereafter informed that my services would no longer be needed. As per our agreement to pay me bi-monthly, Ms. Bushee agreed to pay me a half-month's salary. On June 19, I was given a check for part of my monthly salary as Campaign Manager, in the amount of \$1,750.

On Friday, November 15, I received a call from Joe Lennihan, on behalf of the Bushee Campaign, asking me if I would swap checks, so my payment was noted as coming from the Bushee's Seed Money Account and not from the account the check I was given on June 19 (see, attached Cashier's Check in the amount of \$1,750). I informed Joe Lennihan that I would not swap out the check and give back the money. I also advised Joe Lennihan that I wanted to make sure the June 19 cashier's check was reported in Ms. Bushee's filing, because that was when I actually received the initial payment. Mr. Lennihan acknowledged that he did not know what checks would be reported, but the decision was up to me to decide what to do with the additional check. On November 19, prior to receiving the second check that evening, I emailed Santa Fe City clerk, Yolanda Vigil, to seek advice on whether to accept the second check. In her email, Ms. Vigil informed me that she would not be able to advise me and I needed to submit a complaint form to the Ethics and Campaign Review Board.

Councilor Bushee and other members,

Back in January I sent you the email copied below.

I find it disturbing that only a few months later, I need to remind you again that the ban on magazines you are considering is in violation of state constitutional law.

Article 2, Section 6 of our state's constitution reads as follows:

"Sec. 6. [Right to bear arms.]

No law shall abridge the right of the citizen to keep and bear arms for security and defense, for lawful hunting and recreational use and for other lawful purposes, but nothing herein shall be held to permit the carrying of concealed weapons. No municipality or county shall regulate, in any way, an incident of the right to keep and bear arms."

Note the language- "in any way." This is very clear. You cannot ban high capacity magazines- this is a clear attempt to regulate the ability of law-abiding citizens to bear high-capacity firearms- this is unconstitutional.

Please concern yourselves with upholding the law, not trying to circumvent it. It is your duty and obligation to do so. Once again, I will point out to you that criminals will not care what the law says. All you are considering is taking away the liberties of your law-abiding citizens. I will not stand for that.







Public Funding Talking Points

Q: In 2012, your campaign centered around the importance of accepting public campaign funding to keep big money out of city government. What has changed?

A: I have worked hard for 18 years to cut down on wasteful spending and keep special interest money out of the Santa Fe City Council and I will continue to do just that as Mayor. I still believe the current public campaign finance laws are ample for our City Council elections and I believe every voter deserves an opportunity to hear what I believe on the issues. However, the limitations imposed at the Mayoral level will make it impossible to effectively reach out to the 47,000 registered voters in the City.

Q: Is the recent decision to privately fund your Mayoral campaign an indication that you no longer support Santa Fe's public campaign financing for municipal races?

A: Since the 2012 election, I have expressed concern to City Attorney, Geno Zamora, about the current shortcomings in our public campaign finance laws and the need to address them prior to the 2014 municipal elections. Those issues have not been resolved and I believe the time to start reaching out to voters about my campaign is now. I wholeheartedly support Santa Fe having clean and fair elections and will work as Mayor to find a viable solution to ensure Santa Feans get the representation they deserve.

Q: Why have you chosen to not accept the public campaign funding?

A: Current public campaign finance laws prohibit a candidate from spending money until December. I am serious about being Santa Fe's next Mayor and believe Santa Feans deserve to hear where I stand on the issues and what they can expect from me as Mayor. With over 47,000 registered voters within city limits and the potential for an additional 13,000 more voters to be phased in prior to 2014, I believe I owe it to every voter to start now.

Q: Do you think that \$60,000 isn't sufficient to run for Mayor?

A: I feel the restrictions on in-kind donations and the uncertainty in some of the language used in our current laws, make it difficult to effectively communicate where I stand on the issues to 47,000 registered Santa Feans on a \$60,000 budget. Santa Feans deserve the opportunity to hear from each individual candidate and with a \$60,000 budget and a restriction of not being able to use it until December, I believe it will be difficult for anyone who accepts public campaign funding on a Mayoral race.

Q: Will you accept big dollar donations/special interest money?

A: This campaign will be no different than any other campaign I have run over the last 18 years. I have always opposed special interest money in city politics and will continue to do so while funded privately or publicly. I have personally imposed a \$1,000 cap on all donations to my campaign, the same as the cap in our City Council elections, to ensure an emphasis is still placed on in-district small dollar donations.

CONSULTING AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into this 1st day of June 2013, by and between Tarin Nix (“Consultant”) and Patti Bushee for Mayor Campaign (“Client”).

WHEREAS, the Client requires the general consulting and campaign management services of the Consultant to assist the Client, and Consultant desires to provide such services to the Client as set forth in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual covenants and undertakings hereinafter set forth, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. **Engagement and Acceptance.** The Client here by engages the Consultant to provide general consulting and campaign management for the Patti Bushee for Mayor campaign. Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:
 - i. Write and execute a campaign plan, in partnership with campaign consultants and advisors.
 - ii. Manage staff and campaign organization, as well as work with campaign advisors.
 - iii. Oversee day-to-day operations, including: fundraising, field, messaging, constituency outreach, and candidate’s schedule.
 - iv. Draft and manage the campaign budget.
 - v. Organize and staff campaign events.
 - vi. Candidate and opposition research.
 - vii. Maintain the Client’s database.
 - viii. Fulfill all end of campaign close out duties and assist the transition team.

2. **Relationship of the Parties.** The Consultant shall be acting and performing as an independent contractor, relying on her expertise, knowledge, judgment and techniques in the performance of her responsibilities hereunder. Neither party shall be considered to be the agent of the other.

3. **Compensation.** The Client shall pay to the Consultant a fee payable as follows:
 - a. \$3,500 monthly salary starting June 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014, unless otherwise terminated under subsections 4.
 - b. Client agrees to reimburse Consultant for any travel-related expenses, to include: event parking and out-of-district campaign-related travel.

4. **Duration of Agreement.** This agreement shall remain in effect until either party terminates the Agreement upon fourteen days written notice to the other party and shall commence upon the signing of this Agreement.

5. **Venue.** This Agreement shall be governed and constructed under the laws of the State of New Mexico applicable to contracts executed and to be fully performed within such jurisdiction. Laws or rules that might cause the application of the laws of another jurisdiction shall not apply. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contract, or the breach hereof, shall be finally settled by arbitration in Santa Fe, County before a panel of three neutral arbitrators in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. Judgment upon the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction. The parties consent to the personal jurisdiction of the United States District Court of New Mexico should any order in aid of arbitration be necessary. No Party shall seek to transfer any case or proceedings brought in such court to another forum.

6. **Notices.** Any notice or communication required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and shall be sent by certified, registered or express mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid as follows:

2. Consultant shall use the Confidential Information only for the purpose of evaluating potential business and investment relationships with Discloser.

3. Consultant shall limit disclosure of Confidential Information within its own organization to its directors, officers, partners, members and/or employees having a need to know and shall not disclose Confidential Information to any third party (whether an individual, corporation, or other entity) without the prior written consent of Client. Consultant shall have satisfied its obligations under this paragraph if it takes affirmative measures to ensure compliance with these confidentiality obligations by its employees, agents, consultants and others who are permitted access to or use of the Confidential Information.

4. This Agreement imposes no obligation upon the Consultant with respect to any Confidential Information (a) that was in the Consultant’s possession before receipt from the Client; (b) is or becomes a matter of public knowledge through no fault of the Consultant; (c) is rightfully received by the Consultant from a third party not owing a duty of confidentiality to the Client; (d) is disclosed without a duty of confidentiality to a third party by, or with the authorization of, the Client; or (e) is independently developed by the Consultant.

5. Client warrants that he/she has the right to make the disclosures under this Agreement.

6. This Agreement shall not be construed as creating, conveying, transferring, granting or conferring upon the Consultants any rights, license or authority in or to the information exchanged, except the

limited right to use Confidential Information specified in paragraph 2. Furthermore and specifically, no license or conveyance of any intellectual property rights is granted or implied by this Agreement.

7. Neither party has an obligation under this Agreement to purchase any service, goods, or intangibles from the other party. Discloser may, at its sole discretion, using its own information, offer such products and/or services for sale and modify them or discontinue sale at any time. Furthermore, both parties acknowledge and agree that the exchange of information under this Agreement shall not commit or bind either party to any present or future contractual relationship (except as specifically stated herein), nor shall the exchange of information be construed as an inducement to act or not to act in any given manner.

8. Neither party shall be liable to the other in any manner whatsoever for any decisions, obligations, costs or expenses incurred, changes in business practices, plans, organization, products, services, or otherwise, based on either party's decision to use or rely on any information exchanged under this Agreement.

9. If there is a breach or threatened breach of any provision of this Agreement, it is agreed and understood that the Client shall have no adequate remedy in money or other damages and accordingly shall be entitled to injunctive relief; provided however, no specification in this Agreement of any particular remedy shall be construed as a waiver or prohibition of any other remedies in the event of a breach or threatened breach of this Agreement.

10. This Agreement states the entire agreement between the parties concerning the disclosure of Confidential Information and supersedes any prior agreements, understandings, or representations with respect thereto. Any addition or modification to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties. This Agreement is made under and shall be construed according to the laws of the State of New Mexico. In the event that this agreement is breached, any and all disputes must be settled in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of New Mexico.

11. If any of the provisions of this Agreement are found to be unenforceable, the remainder shall be enforced as fully as possible and the unenforceable provision(s) shall be deemed modified to the limited extent required to permit enforcement of the Agreement as a whole.

WHEREFORE, the parties acknowledge that they have read and understand this Agreement and voluntarily accept the duties and obligations set forth herein.



Patti for Mayor Campaign Summer Campaign Plan & Calendar

CONFIDENTIAL

The voters of the city of Santa Fe will elect a new Mayor on March 4, 2014 to fill the seat vacated by Mayor David Coss. This plan outlines how Councilwoman Patti Bushee's can maximize the summer to ensure her record of results and lifetime of community service remain at the forefront of the Santa Fe municipal elections. The activities described here are designed to create a sense of contagious momentum behind her campaign and maximize her ability to win in 2014.

LANDSCAPE

With four potential Mayoral candidates announced, Councilwoman Patti Bushee is considered the frontrunner for Mayor of Santa Fe. However, with a few months remaining for additional candidates to enter the race, more focus needs to be placed on developing a dynamic and active campaign this summer. Councilwoman Patti Bushee's role in the community provides a critical element to her campaign and the support to develop a district-wide grassroots field campaign.

STRATEGY

A strong foundation is key to any winning campaign and that starts with research, a committed group of core supporters, and a thoroughly thought out campaign plan. These, coupled a dedication to fundraising, will create an environment that allows for a full grassroots volunteer program by September.

Research – Opposition research books will be compiled on all Santa Fe Mayoral candidates to aid with messaging and development of talking points. Books will include but are not limited too: record while in public office, voter history, personal finances & tax payment records, professional experiences, media, and legal cases.

Administrative – There are specific day-to-day functions that need to be addressed prior to the campaign kickoff. Duties include but are not limited too: getting the voterfile updated, securing an office rental, setting up the office, purchasing office equipment, overseeing the website development and site text, compiling previous campaign data, developing a online campaign presence on Facebook and building a network of online supporters, development and purchasing of business cards and campaign literature, establish additional earned media and promotion, and developing an aggressive campaign and field plan.

Fundraising – Councilwoman Patti Bushee’s commitment to the residents of Santa Fe will undoubtedly create an expansive list of supporters and donors throughout the next ten months. While a majority of the money needed to run a successful campaign can wait until after summer, there is a growing need to raise \$25,000 this summer to ensure the campaign can create the foundation needed. A strong and effective fundraising program will need a central recording system to track fundraising calls and incoming donations, as well as the ability to accept online donations. The campaign will work to build new fundraising opportunities over the summer and set up private fundraisers for the fall.

FUTURE CAMPAIGN NEEDS


There are a couple of administrative tasks that need to be addressed prior to everyone’s summer vacations.

- 1.) An individual other than Patti needs to be added to the bank account and given the authority to issue checks. Some checks will need to be written while Patti is on vacation through mid-July. - 5.) A decision will need to be made regarding what database we will use online and for tracking donations. Since donations are starting to come in, we want to make sure we track everything by the book.

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
