RE: **ADDENDUM NO. 2 to Specifications and Contract Documents for the Santa Fe River Channel Improvements (Phase 3a): Boulder Grade Control Reconstruction, CIP #500B**



The following clarifications and corrections shall be incorporated into the bid documents for the above-referenced project, and shall be reflected in the Contractor's bid submittal for construction of the project. Any portion of the contract documents not specifically modified or referenced herein shall remain unchanged.

Amended Bid Proposal Form

1. In response to questions received at the pre-bid meeting, the Bid Proposal Form has been reissued to correct several typographical errors and adjust some quantities. Bidder is hereby instructed to use the attached A.5a Bid Form in lieu of the form included in the Project Manual. Note that this amended form also includes the typographical corrections made in Addendum #1.

Responses to Questions

The following questions were asked at the pre-bid meeting and subsequent site visit. No additional questions were received.

2. Question: If a contractor is not able to work a full 8-hour day due to weather conditions, will that count against the "60 weather working days" identified in the bid book?
Answer: Generally, if any work is done on a given day, that will count as a work day, regardless of the exact number of hours. However, if the contractor feels that a weather-shortened day may impact their ability to meet the contract timeline, that delay should be documented for possible negotiation of additional time at the end of the project.
3. Question: Detail A, Sheet 10 calls for compaction to "95% MP." Since that is an open-graded riprap, will the contractor be required to test the actual level of compaction?
Answer: No, testing will not be required for compaction of the stone base course; however, compaction will be required to create a firm, stable bed of riprap to protect the structure toe. Note that this also applies to the same note in Details E and F on Sheet 9.
4. Question: Items 12, 14, 15, and 20 on the Bid Form appear to have incorrect units associated with the bid items.
Answer: The attached amended Bid Form has corrected those units.

5. Question: Have any locations been identified for harvesting the willow whips? Are there enough locations within a 40-mile radius, or can that be expanded, if necessary?

Answer: *The intent is to obtain willow cuttings from as close to the project site as possible, to provide the maximum chance of their survival. No specific sites have been identified, but several sources have been identified anecdotally. It is the City's understanding that most of the revegetation specialists in the area are aware of suitable sources. Nonetheless, if necessary, the specified harvesting radius may be expanded if the contractor can persuade the City that suitable stock or necessary quantities cannot be obtained within 40 miles of the site.*

6. Question: Assuming that cut banks outside of the channel bottom will need to be revegetated, the reseeding area quantities seem low on the Bid Form.

Answer: *The reseeding quantities on the original bid form reflected only the areas identified on the plans, and did not account for the additional seeding of the cut banks. The amended Bid Form (attached) increases those quantities to account for the additional seeding areas.*

7. Question: What is the reason for the negative quantity for Unclassified Excavation (Bid Item 14) under the Additive Alternate?

Answer: *Per NMDOT specifications, the bid item for Unclassified Excavation is measured as the amount of Cut material excavated from the channel bed. Since the Additive Alternate would result in construction of a grade control structure that will raise the channel bed upstream of that structure, less excavation will be required from BOP to Sta. 3+50 under the Additive Alternate than would be required under the Base Bid, resulting in a smaller overall quantity of Unclassified Excavation if the Additive Alternate is awarded. Refer to the Earthwork Cross Sections on Sheets 11 for a graphic representation.*

8. Question: Have any sources of boulders been identified? Does the rock need to match, or can basalt be substituted?

Answer: *Beyond re-use of existing material from the failed grade control structure, no outside sources of boulders have been identified. Bidders are reminded to refer to the Supplemental Technical Specification modifying Section 602 for more specific information on allowable boulders for the project. In particular, per Section 602.2.1.1, the boulders must match the existing stone, so basalt will not be acceptable.*

Receipt of this Addendum must be acknowledged by the bidder on Page A-32, Item 4.
