10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **DIRECTING STAFF TO EXPLORE THE OPTIONS FOR ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM**
12 **WHEREBY RETIRED AND REFURBISHED CITY COMPUTERS WILL BE AVAILABLE**
13 **FOR DONATION TO INDIGENT CHILDREN AND YOUTH.**

15 **WHEREAS**, in the current technological society in which we live, the use of computers by
16 children and youth has become a necessity in their everyday lives; and

17 **WHEREAS**, students require computers to complete school assignments, research, and
18 submit class projects in print or online; and

19 **WHEREAS**, although, our public libraries have computers available for use by the public,
20 there are a limited amount available at any given time; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the City retires computers from time to time in an effort to keep hardware
22 systems upgraded for the City of Santa Fe; and


23 **WHEREAS**, in effort to assist indigent children and youth in Santa Fe, the Governing Body
24 desires to have retired City computers, including desktops and laptops, refurbished and data removed
25 from such computers to prepare them for donation to indigent children and youth in Santa Fe through

1 a program that will be developed by staff.


2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Governing Body of the City of Santa
3 Fe directs staff to explore the options for establishing a program whereby retired and refurbished City
4 computers, including desktops and laptops, will be available for donation to indigent children and
5 youth.

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that within 60 days of adoption of this resolution, staff shall
7 present the program details to the Governing Body including any fiscal impact that may result due to
8 the establishment of the program.
