**A RESOLUTION**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR RECEIPT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR A CITY WIDE PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL HEAD UPGRADE PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico (“City”) has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer state and federal funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City submitted an application for New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds for the purpose of upgrading 415 pedestrian signal heads at 58 intersections to the countdown type pedestrian signals (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded funding for the Project by the NMDOT and must adopt a resolution of support for the Project and enter into a cooperative project agreement with NMDOT to receive the funding; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization (SFMPO) Transportation  
2 Policy Board approved the Project for placement in the FFY 2014-2017 Transportation  
3 Improvement Program; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Project is programmed in the NMDOT's Statewide Transportation  
5 Improvement Program approved by the New Mexico State Transportation Commission and  
6 Federal Highway Administration; and


7           **WHEREAS**, funding for the Project construction, in the amount of \$300,000, has been  
8 approved for FFY 2015 and such funding requires a 0% local government match; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the City is required to be responsible for the maintenance of the Project,  
10 over the useable life of the Project.

11           **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
12 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico:

- 13           1. Supports construction of the Project (NMDOT Project Control Number S100270)  
14           funded through a cooperative project agreement with NMDOT;
- 15           2. Accepts responsibility for the project;
- 16           3. Assumes the lead role for the design development and construction of the project;
- 17           4. Agrees to the terms, conditions and certification and reporting requirements of  
18           the cooperative project agreement; and
- 19           5. Assumes ownership, liability, maintenance, and related amenities of the Project,  
20           and assures the NMDOT that sufficient funding for the local match and for  
21           upfront project costs is available.




