19	WHEREAS, increased use of public transportation will reduce traffic congestion as
20	voters travel to and from polling locations; and
21	WHEREAS, free public transportation provides transportation to polling locations for
22	citizens who may have no other transportation available or who cannot afford regular fares; and
23	WHEREAS, eliminating fares on an election day encourages people to try public
24	transportation and thereby promote its use.
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE

1	CITY OF SANTA FE that the City of Santa Fe Transit Division is authorized to provide free
2	rides on Santa Fe Trails bus routes and Santa Fe Ride vehicles for all Santa Fe municipal
3	elections, and Santa Fe County primary and general elections.
