A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CITY'S PROJECT
APPLICATION TO THE SANTA FE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017 NMDOT ADMINISTERED FUNDS
FROM THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM AND RECREATIONAL
TRAILS PROGRAM.
WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer
federal funds; and
WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe desires to submit an application for Federal Fiscal Year
2016/2017 (FFY16/17) for New Mexico Transportation Alternatives Program ("TAP") funds in the
amount of \$320,000, as set forth by the Federal legislation, Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st
Century (MAP-21) and as outlined in the FFY 16/17 New Mexico TAP Guide; and
WHEREAS, the project named below will be included in the TAP application and are
eligible project(s) under New Mexico TAP and MAP-21:
1. Arroyo Chamiso Trail @ SF Place Mall (Phase I) - cost \$320,000 with match of

\$46,592

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe desires to submit an application for Federal Fiscal Year 2016/2017 (FFY16/17) for New Mexico Recreational Trails Program ("RTP") funds in the amount of \$400,000, as set forth by the Federal legislation, Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) and as outlined in the FFY 16/17 New Mexico RTP Guide; and,

WHEREAS, the projects named below will be included in the RTP application and are eligible project(s) under New Mexico TAP and MAP-21:

- 1. La Tierra Trails North Connector cost \$150,000 and match \$21,840
- 2. La Tierra Trails South Connector cost \$250,000 and match \$36,400

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe acknowledges availability of the required local match of 14.56% and the availability of funds to pay all upfront costs, since TAP and RTP are cost reimbursement programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe agrees to pay any costs that exceed the project amount if the applications are selected for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, agrees to maintain all project(s) constructed with TAP and RTP funding for the useable life of the project(s).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body:

- 1. Authorizes staff to submit an application for FFY16/17 New Mexico TAP funds in the amount of \$320,000 and RTP funds in the amount of \$400,000 from the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) on behalf of the residents of the city of Santa Fe.
- 2. Assures the NMDOT that if TAP and RTP funds are awarded, sufficient funding for the local match and for upfront project costs are available, since TAP and RTP are reimbursement programs, and that any costs exceeding the award amounts will be paid for by the City of Santa Fe.
 - 3. Assures NMDOT that if awarded TAP and RTP funds, sufficient funding for the

1	operation and maintenance of the TAP and KTP projects will be available for the life of the projects.
2	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:
3	1. The City of Santa Fe is authorized to enter into a Cooperative Project Agreemen
4	with the NMDOT for construction of TAP and RTP projects using these funds as set forth by MAP-
5	21 on behalf of the residents of Santa Fe.
6	2. City staff is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and
7	act as the official representative of the City of Santa Fe in this and subsequent related activities.
8	6. The Governing Body assures the NMDOT that the City of Santa Fe is willing and
9	able to administer all activities associated with the proposed projects.
