## CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-53 INTRODUCED BY:** 3 4 5 Councilor Christopher Rivera Mayor Javier Gonzales 6 Councilor Ron Trujillo Councilor Peter Ives 7 Councilor Signe Lindell Councilor Joseph Maestas 8 Councilor Carmichael Dominguez 9 10 **A RESOLUTION** 11 RELATING TO PAY FOR NON-UNION, CLASSIFIED, TERM AND EXEMPT EMPLOYEES; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO IDENTIFY AND IMPLEMENT AN 12 ADJUSTMENT IN SALARY COMMENSURATE TO THOSE RECEIVED BY UNIONIZED 13 EMPLOYEES OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS AND AUTHORIZING A 2% SALARY 14 ADJUSTMENT BE INCLUDED IN THE FISCAL 2015/2016 BUDGET FOR NON-UNION 15 16 CLASSIFIED, TERM AND EXEMPT EMPLOYEES. 17 WHEREAS, City of Santa Fe employees who are members of a related union have received 18 19 regular raises over the last five (5) years; and 20 WHEREAS, City of Santa Fe Firefighters Association secured several raises for its members over the last five (5) years, including a 1% base rate adjustment in 2009/2010, a 2% cost of living 21 22 adjustment in 2011/2012, and a 2% base rate adjustment in 2012/2013; and 23 WHEREAS, City of Santa Fe Police Officers Association secured several raises for both 24 commissioned and non-commissioned members over the last five (5) years, including a 2% base rate 25 adjustment in 2009/2010, and a 2% base rate adjustment in 2012/2013; and

WHEREAS, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees 1 2 (AFSCME) secured several raises for its members over the last five (5) years, including a 4% base 3 rate adjustment in 2009/2010 and a 2% base rate adjustment in 2012/2013; and 4 WHEREAS, non-union classified employees have not received any pay or cost of living 5 adjustments over the same time period; and 6 WHEREAS, the ongoing budget constraints facing the City of Santa Fe, due in large part to 7 reduced gross receipts taxes, has forced the City to forgo raises for employees not required by union 8 contracts; and 9 WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes that while the budget is, and will remain, 10 constrained, non-union employees serving in classified positions should not be left behind when 11 raises for other groups of City employees have been provided on a regular basis; and 12 NOW THERFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF 13 THE CITY OF SANTA FE, STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the Governing Body directs the City 14 Manager and relevant staff to identify and implement an adjustment in salary commensurate to those 15 received by unionized employees over the last five (5) years and hereby authorizes a 2% salary 16 adjustment be included in the fiscal year budget for non-union classified, term and exempt 17 employees.. 18 PASSED, APPROVED and ADOPTED this 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015. 19 20 21 MAYOR JAVIER M.
