
## CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-55** 2 INTRODUCED BY: 3 4 Councilor Signe Lindell 5 Mayor Javier Gonzales 6 Councilor Peter Ives 7 Councilor Carmichael Dominguez 8 Councilor Chris Rivera 9 **A RESOLUTION** 10 AUTHORIZING MOBILE VEHICLE VENDORS WITHIN THE PLAZA PERIPHERY 11 AREA AT SPECIFIC LOCATIONS AND AT LIMITED TIMES, PURSUANT TO THE 12 **VEHICLE VENDOR ORDINANCE, 18-8.9 SFCC 1987,** 13 14 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2014, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2014-49 to 15 declare its desire to bring people to the Santa Fe Plaza, to provide increased economic development 16 opportunities, and to provide for creative and evolving usage of the Santa Fe Plaza; and 17 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2014-49 directed city staff to analyze current city ordinances 18 related to food sales on the Plaza and to recommend ordinance amendments if necessary, and to bring 19 forward additional recommendations that would enhance the experience of the Plaza for residents and 20 visitors and ultimately bring people to the Plaza; and 21 WHEREAS, on June 10, 2015, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2015-13 which 22 established the Vehicle Vendor Ordinance, 18-8.9 SFCC 1987; and 23 WHEREAS, the Vehicle Vendor Ordinance prohibits vehicle vendors within the Plaza 24 Periphery Area, prohibits mobile vehicle vendors from parking for more than three (3) hours at any 25

1	location, and prohibits mobile vehicle vendors from parking within one hundred fifty (150) feet of the	
2	street-level entrance to any restaurant, unless such prohibited activities are authorized by a resolution	
3	of the Governing Body.	
4	NOW, THEREF	ORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
5	CITY OF SANTA FE	that pursuant to the provisions of 18-8.9(C)(7), 18-8.9(D)(3), and 18-
6	8.9(D)(4) SFCC 1987, effective June 8, 2015 mobile vehicle vendors are authorized within the Plaza	
7	Periphery Area at the following locations and at the following times:	
8	<u>Locations</u> : T	Three (3) on-street parking spaces identified on the "PLAZA PERIPHERY
9	· A	REA – VEHICLE VENDOR MAP" below.
10	<u>Times</u> : 6	:00pm to 2:30am.
11	Exceptions: N	Mobile vehicle vendors are not authorized at the above locations during the
12	p	ermit period, or twenty-four (24) hours prior to the commencement of the
13	р	ermit period, of any major commercial event permitted by the city pursuant
14	to	\$23-5.2 SFCC 1987 or any other special event permitted by the city within
15	tł	ne Plaza Periphery area that requires the use of the above locations by the
16	S	pecial event sponsor.
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:	
18	(1) City staff	shall install parking signs at the locations identified by this resolution. The
19	signs shall state that parking is prohibited by vehicles, other than mobile vehicle vendors, during the	
20	times identified above; and	
21	(2) Mobile ve	ehicle vendors parked at these locations shall remain in compliance with the
22	Vehicle Vendor Ordinance at all times.	
23	(3) Licensed	Mobile Vehicle Vendors shall pay a "Supplemental Plaza Periphery Fee" of
24	\$150.00 to vend at the above locations	
25	(4) The city	manager is authorized to adopt administrative procedures for the

management and enforcement of the use of the above locations should the need arise.
