15	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:		
16	Section 1. Section 12-6-6.1 of the City of Santa Fe Uniform Traffic is amended to		
17	read:		
18	12-6-6.1 STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN		
19	SPECIFIED PLACES.		
20	A. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoi		
21	conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police		
22	officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following places:		
23	(1) on a sidewalk;		
24	(2) in front of a public or private driveway;		
25	(3) within an intersection;		

1	(4)	in a marked bicycle lane;
2	(<u>5</u> [4])	within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant;
3	(<u>6</u> [5])	on a crosswalk;
4	(<u>7</u> [6])	within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
5	(<u>8</u> [7])	within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon,
6		stop sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a street;
7	(<u>9</u> [8])	between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty (30)
8		feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety
9		zone, unless the traffic authority indicates a different length by signs
10		or markings;
11	(<u>10</u> [9])	within fifty (50) feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
12	(<u>11</u> [10])within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station
13		and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station
14		within seventy-five (75) feet of said entrance, when properly
15		signposted;
16	(<u>12</u> [11	-alongside or opposite any excavation or obstruction when stopping,
17		standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
18	(<u>13</u> [12])on the street side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or
19		curb of a street;
20	(<u>14</u> [13	3])upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a street or within
21		a street tunnel;
22	(15[14])at any place where official signs prohibit stopping (66-7-351 NMSA
23		198);
24	(16[15	5])on any railroad track; or

1	$(\underline{17}[16])$ between a curb and sidewalk or between a curb or lateral line of a		
2	roadway, and the adjacent property line. (*)		
3	B. No person shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his control into any such		
4	prohibited area or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful. (66-7-351		
5	NMSA 1978)		
6	C. The foregoing provisions may be modified by the administrator or their[his]		
7	designated representative upon the basis of an engineering and traffic		
8	investigation study by the use of appropriate markings, signs or parking meter		
9	(*).		
10	Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
