## CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-58** INTRODUCED BY: 3 4 Councilor Peter Ives 5 6 7 8 9 10 **A RESOLUTION** DIRECTING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES STAFF TO CREATE A "CARBON NEUTRAL 11 IMPACT REPORT" (CNIR) FORM DESIGNED TO IDENTIFY AND QUANTIFY CARBON 12 EMISSIONS STEMMING FROM PROPOSED CITY RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES AND 13 OTHER ACTIONS, IN ORDER TO BETTER ASCERTAIN THEIR POSITIVE OR 14 NEGATIVE EFFECTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT; REQUIRING CITY STAFF TO USE 15 AND COMPLETE THE CNIR WHEN ASSESSING PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS, 16 ORDINANCES AND OTHER ACTIONS. 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is committed to protecting the long-term health and viability of our community through strategies designed to improve the environment by reducing 20 greenhouse gas emissions and mitigating the effects of climate change; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Governing Body, through the adoption of Resolution No. 2006-55, supported efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 2030; and 23 WHEREAS, the Governing Body, through the adoption of Resolution 2014-85, the 24 25 Governing Body declared its intention of having 50% percent of its energy come from renewable

2 WHEREAS, the Governing Body, through the adoption of Resolution 2014-81, the Governing Body requires city staff to balance the cost of the city's needs with that of producing the 3 lowest carbon footprint the city would create when acquiring and using fuel powered equipment, 4 including vehicles. 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE 6 CITY OF SANTA FE that the Public Utilities Staff is hereby directed to create a "Carbon Neutral 7 Impact Report" (CNIR) form designed to identify and quantify carbon emissions stemming from 8 proposed city resolutions, ordinances and other actions, in order to better ascertain the positive or 9 negative effects they may have on the environment, and that city staff use and complete the CNIR 10 form when assessing proposed resolutions, ordinances and other actions, and submit the form to the 11 Governing Body to be used in their assessment of such proposed matters. 12 PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED this this 24th day of June, 2015. 13 14 15 16 17 JAVIER M.
