CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-60** 2 INTRODUCED BY: 3 4 Councilor Carmichael Dominguez Mayor Javier Gonzales 5 6 Councilor Bill Dimas Councilor Peter Ives 7 Councilor Christopher Rivera Councilor Joseph Maestas 8 Councilor Patti Bushee 9 A RESOLUTION 10 DIRECTING STAFF TO SEND A LETTER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE 11 TO THE NEW MEXICO DELEGATION IN SUPPORT OF THE CCM-CARE ACT 12 THAT WOULD INCREASE CARE FACILITIES AND RESEARCH ON CAVERNOUS 13 ANGIOMA; TRANSMITTING A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE DIRECTORS 14 OF THE NIH, FDA AND CDC URGING THEM TO PROVIDE NECESSARY 15 RESOURCES TO RESEARCH POTENTIAL TREATMENTS FOR CCM. 16 17 WHEREAS, cavernous angiomas ("CCM") are clusters of abnormal blood cells found in 18 the brain and spinal cord that may result in seizures, hemorrhage, or even death; and 19 WHEREAS, CCM can occur spontaneously, or as the result of an inheritable genetic 20 21 defect; and WHEREAS, because of a genetic mutation present in early Spanish settlers, northern 22 New Mexico has one of the highest incidences of CCM anywhere in the world; and 23 WHEREAS, over 1000 families in northern New Mexico are at risk, and members of the 24

Santa Fe City Hall family have been stricken by CCM; and

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1	WHEREAS, genetic testing is available to determine it individuals are susceptible to
2	CCM; and
3	WHEREAS, knowledge of this susceptibility can help individuals who are vulnerable
4	become educated about this trait, and be better able to safeguard their health and their lives; and
5	WHEREAS, City of Santa Fe Resolution #2008-19 established an annual "Cavernous
6	Angioma Awareness Week" to bring attention to this illness that afflicts one person in every 500-
7	600; and
8	WHEREAS, the genetic mutation has passed down through families in New Mexico
9	over 17 generations, with offspring having a 50% chance of inheriting the illness should one of
10	their parents be afflicted with it.
11	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
12	CITY OF SANTA FE directs staff to send a letter on behalf of the City of Santa Fe to the New
13	Mexico Congressional delegation in support of the CCM-CARE Act that would increase care
14	facilities and research on cavernous angioma, including a center based at UNM.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
16	Directors of the NIH, FDA and CDC, urging them to provide the necessary resources to research
17	potential treatments for cavernous angioma
