The Santa Fe Regional Juvenile Justice Board was called to order at 5:19 p.m. by Mr. Sam Jackson, Chair. A quorum was established at 5:29 p.m.

3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Deacon Trujillo moved to approve the agenda as presented, with a second by Mr. Lovato which passed by voice vote.

4. INTRODUCTIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Introductions we made by all present.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM DECEMBER 17, 2015

Chair Jackson moved to approve the minutes of December 17, 2015 as presented, with a second by Deacon Trujillo which passed by voice vote.

6. FINANCIAL REPORT-Richard DeMella

A. Budget- Detailed Budget and Financial Report

Mr. DeMella presented the Financial Report (See Exhibit A). He discussed the matches and balances for the month of December.

B. Approval of Financial Report

Mr. Lovato moved to approve the Financial Report as presented, with a second by Deacon Trujillo which passed by voice vote.

7. PRESENTATIONS:

A. Strategic Plan JJAC Unit

This item will be moved to the next meeting.

Judge Sommer asked the Ms. Pathak take the place of Ms. Jacobs who is no longer a member. Mr. DeMella will start the process to get her as a member.

8. MATTERS FROM THE BOARD

A. Day Reporting Program Committee

Mr. DeMella explained the program committee met (See Exhibit B) and reviewed their discussions and decisions. The MOU for the Day Reporting Program was signed it is currently at Finance from there it will go to City Council. Mr. DeMella explained the left over money could be used for other programs or used to enhance them.

A discussion was held about the inactivity of the program. It was agreed that if the contract has not been signed and services have not been provided, that it should not be funded until it has been signed.

Ms. Gonzales stated she was told her program could not so much as make phone calls until the contract was signed.

Mr. DeMella discussed the funding and the amounts moved around for the ICM Program last year. He wants to ensure the program can run until the end of this year. Last year it had to end in April. Upon approval of the BAR tonight, Mr. DeMella will submit it tomorrow.

Mr. DeMella discussed the Gender Specific program and how some funding can be put into it, the Boys and Girls Club are willing to allow two sessions. Ms. Romero would like to clarify if that is two or two of each group, Mr. DeMella will find out and email the Board.

Mr. Lovato would like to make sure that someone can facilitate this with the schools. Ms. Mann-Lev has the staff to do that.

Mr. DeMella will also move some funding into Strengthening Families and Communities in Schools.

Mr. Lovato suggested to Communities in Schools that they expand to Santa Fe High. Ms. Dunsay will make sure it is discussed.

B. ACTION ITEM: Vote on BAR

Judge Sommer moved to approve the BAR with a second by Deacon Trujillo which passed by voice vote.

Deacon Trujillo briefly discussed the idea to have more services at Santa Fe High School if CYFD allows it.

Chair Jackson stated as soon as the BAR is approved the money can be moved around to the different programs.

Mr. DeMella stated that JJAC will present at the next meeting, they were unable to make it tonight.

9. MATTERS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mr. DeMellia announced that a Diner Hub and at Boys and Girls Club will provide hot meals on the Southside to families in need once a day. The Food Depot will be partners and contract a cook. Part of the Federal requirements is to have a tutoring component. Mr. Lovato suggested that they also contact Youthworks who has a Culinary Component as well to assist. The Diner Hub will be available Monday through Friday from 5-7:30 p.m.

Mr. DeMella discussed that when Day Reporting begins, there is discussion to open a Teen Center. Girls Inc. can help with issues like financial literacy and other resources that teens need. They are hoping to have it open by July 1, 2016.

Deacon Trujillo discussed the change that Cesar Chavez School received in their grade. It went from D to B due to the CIS program and the work by Ms. Hilda Perez-Vargas has done He would like to know if there is a way to find out the statistics so that it may be possible to have the program work in other schools around the city.

Ms. Dunsay stated their new database and tracking system has made it easier to find out what was working.

A student from Capital High School was in attendance who is a tutor at Cesar Chavez and a basketball coach mentioned he has noticed the difference that the program has made.

There being no further business to come before the Santa Fe Regional Juvenile Justice Board, the meeting adjourned at 5:46 p.m. which passed by unanimous voice vote.

As per the half year funding review Day Reporting there will be a \$32,538.00 surplus for the remaining year.

Since the contract for Day Reporting has not yet been signed, but should be signed by early February, and since per CYFD rules and regulations, we cannot pay for services until a contract has been signed, it appears that there will be a surplus of \$32,538 that they will not be able to use this fiscal year. The Program Committee met January 15, and agreed that this is the best use of that money.

ICM will receive \$15,000. Add that to the original amount of \$42,108, and the transfer of \$1,938 from Contractual Services, and a transfer of \$1,000 from travel; and ICM has a total of \$60,046 for the current fiscal year. Based upon past experience, this should be sufficient to provide ICM services until the end of this fiscal year.

ICM \$42,108 increase thru the Contractual Services of \$1,938 and travel of \$1,000.00 for a total of \$45,046.00 Increase by \$15,000 to a new total of \$60,046.00

Gender Specific: \$4,785 increase by \$3,215 for a total of \$8,000

Boys and Girls. This will allow two sessions for boys and two sessions for girls.

Strengthening Families \$6,910.00 increase by \$1,000.00 a total of \$7,910.00

CIS \$30,175.00 increase by \$13,323 a total of **\$43,498.00**. The Program Committee requested that CIS get matching numbers to the Board in a timely manner so that the Board can report this match to CYFD in a timely manner.
