10 AN ORDINANCE

11 AMENDING SECTION 4-1 SFCC 1987 AND SUBSECTION 4-4.4 SFCC 1987 RELATED TO  
12 LIQUOR LICENSE TAXES AND PROVIDING FOR STAGGERED RENEWAL DATES.

13  
14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

15 Section 1. Section 4-1 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1968-6, §2) is amended to read:

16 4-1 DEFINITIONS.

17 The definitions used in the Liquor Excise Tax Act, Chapter 7, Article 17 NMSA 1978 and the  
18 Liquor Control Act, [Sections 7-17-1 through 7-17-11, 7-24-1 through 7-24-5 and 60-3-1 through  
19 60-11-4] Chapter 60, Articles 3A, 5A, 6A, 6B, 6C, 6E, 7A, 7B and 8A NMSA 1978 are adopted by  
20 reference. [for the purposes of this chapter.]

21 Section 2. Subsection 4-4.4 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1968-6, § 3, as amended) is  
22 amended to read:

23 4-4.4 City Liquor License Tax; Staggered Liquor License Renewal Dates.

24 A. Pursuant to Sections 7-24-1 and [~~60-6A-16~~] 60-6B-5 NMSA 1978, annual city liquor  
25 license taxes on the privileges of persons holding dispenser, retailer and canopy liquor licenses issued

1 by the state are imposed an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), payable on or before July 1  
2 of each year. The license year for dispenser, retailer and canopy liquor licenses shall expire on June 30,  
3 unless renewed. The city may reissue the licenses annually, on or before July 1, upon payment of the  
4 annual license fee. [as follows:

5 (1) ~~Dispenser: an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);~~

6 (2) ~~Retailer: an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);~~

7 (3) ~~Club: an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);~~


8 (4) ~~Restaurant: an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);~~

9 (5) ~~Canopy: an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250).]~~

10 B. Pursuant to Sections 7-24-1 and 60-6B-5 NMSA 1978, city liquor license taxes on  
11 the privileges of persons holding restaurant, club, wholesaler and manufacturer liquor licenses issued  
12 by the state are imposed a fee of eighty-five dollars (\$85), payable on or before July 1, 2016. The  
13 license for restaurant, club, wholesaler and manufacturer liquor licenses shall expire on October 31,  
14 2016, unless renewed. The city may reissue the licenses, on or before November 1, 2016, upon payment  
15 of the annual license fee referenced in Subsection C, below. [The licenses specified in Subsection A of  
16 this section shall be re-issued annually on or about July 1 of each year upon the payment of the annual  
17 license fee.]

18 C. Pursuant to Sections 7-24-1 and 60-6B-5 NMSA 1978, annual city liquor license  
19 taxes on the privileges of persons holding restaurant, club, wholesaler and manufacturer liquor  
20 licenses issued by the state are imposed an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), payable on  
21 or before November 1 of each year. The license year for restaurant, club, wholesaler and manufacturer  
22 liquor licenses shall expire on October 31, unless renewed. The city may reissue the licenses annually, on  
23 or before November 1, upon payment of the annual license fee.
