5. Reports and Project Updates

a) Ignite and Pilot Purchase Program

Mr. Tennyson reported that the purchase contracts and site locations are ready to go. At this time, June 30, 2016 is the date for installment of art.

b) Acequia Trail Crossing

Ms. Garcia y Griego reported that the project cleared Public Works and Finance Committee for the construction bid. The tunnel will allow the city to add components upon funding. The final approval will come from the governing body next Wednesday, May 25, 2016. This is a fast track project. Ms. Deitch asked if there will be funding for

damage. Ms. Garcia y Griego said that there is funding for damage. The contract will be awarded on July 1st and the project needs to be done by December, 2016.

6. Action Items

- a) Request for approval of Ignite Proposal by Anne Russell and Christy Hengst, \$10,000

AIPP members received information in their packets on the "Same Boat" proposal to be considered for the Ignite Grant. Same Boat combines artist collaboration, community participation, creative youth engagement and functional. Budget breakdown and Bio's included in packet.

Mr. Chase Daniel moved to approve the request for approval of Ignite Proposal by Anne Russell and Christy Hengst in the amount of \$10,000, second by Ms. Weisman, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

- b) Request for approval of Selection Committee recommendations to appoint Drew Leniham to Art in Public Places Committee

Included in the packet was letter of interest to serve on the AIPP committee and Bio for member review. Mr. Muchmore focused in on the exception grant writing experience that Ms. Leniham possesses and her professional expertise in ~~arts marketing and understanding the importance of budgetary adherence~~. Her many attributes and experience speak for themselves. Ms. Garcia y Griego also added that she is very interested in public policy.

Ms. Deitch moved to approve the recommendation of Ms. Drew Leniham to be appointed to the Art in Public Places Committee, second by Ms. Peer, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

- c) Request for approval of Pilot Youth Mural Collaboration with Children and Youth Commission

Included in the packet was the program summary for the Community Youth Mural Program. This mural program will provide youth (21 years and younger) with: participation in after-school activities, involvement in community service, arts-based apprenticeship/mentorship and training in public art. Detailed information was included on the alignment points of reference with the Children & Youth Indicators and with the Arts Commission opportunities. The proposal is to try this for one-year utilizing bond money that funds public art.

Mr. Chase Daniel moved to approve the request of the Pilot Youth Mural Collaboration with Children and Youth Commission, second by Ms. Peer, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

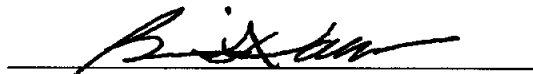
- a) Donation
