## **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Mr. Flores moved to approve the Agenda as published. Mr. Olivas seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

## **INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS AND GUESTS**

Introductions were made and everyone mentioned the topic that they are working on.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES: November 17, 2016 and January 26, 2017**

Approval of the Minutes was postponed so that the Board could prepare for the Youth Summit.

## **MYAB/SFCF VISTA PREPARATION FOR SUMMIT**

Mr. Sanchez distributed and reviewed copies of the handout entitled "2017 Youth Summit Topic Introduction Speech for the Youth Summit" scheduled for March 31, 2016 at the Santa Fe Indian School. A copy is hereby incorporated to these Minutes as Exhibit "A".

Mr. Sanchez noted that they have been meeting for the last three to four Thursdays to get the kids ready for the 2017 Youth Summit. He said the goal for tonight's meeting is to connect with the presenters, discuss the goals for the co-facilitators and go through their introduction speeches.

Mr. Sanchez mentioned that Julie Sanchez and a couple of other people are currently providing this same kind of training to some kids at the Santa Fe Mountain Center because they did not have transportation to attend this meeting.

*(Ms. Sanchez arrived later in the meeting).*

Councilor Villarreal was going to be a co-facilitator at the Youth Summit. She noted that all the City Councilors that are on the Finance Committee have to attend the budget hearings the entire week of the Youth Summit.

Mr. Sanchez said he will review and redo the list of co-facilitators.

When the Youth Summit is done, Mr. Sanchez would like for the kids to prepare a Summit Report based on the results of the Youth Summit. Once the Action Plan is done, he would also like the youth to help reinforce the work that is already being done, or being worked on, in the community, as the result of the last Youth Summit. For example, the Santa Fe Public Schools have implemented policies on bullying and a teen center is currently being developed; and Board Member, Augustine Martinez has been working on a job center for teens and what this would look like.

Mr. Sanchez noted that Marcos Lovato of Ever Wonder Media is making a documentary on the Youth Summit.

Mr. Sanchez reviewed the agenda for the Youth Summit.

Mr. Herrera said they want to be sensitive to the Native American culture and the City of Santa Fe. He said anytime there is an activity at the Santa Fe Indian School, part of the tradition, is asking for the creator to work with the spirits that are around to create a good learning environment – one that everybody gathers information in a positive way.

He noted that there will be a student “drum-group” performing at the beginning and then one of the students will do the innovation in their native language. There will also be a prayer to close the event.

He explained that there is no violation of Church or State because the Santa Fe Indian School is on 150 acres of sovereign property owned and operated by the 19 Pueblos.

Mr. Martinez asked what time the Youth Summit was.

Mr. Sanchez said from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

He said he would like to have some fun activities for the afternoon and have some team building exercises.

*At this point in the meeting, the Board Members and the guests present broke into groups to prepare for the Youth Summit and review their introduction speeches.*

#### **COMMENTS FROM THE CHAIR AND BOARD MEMBERS**

Chair Ibarra reviewed his opening speech for the Youth Summit noting that there has been progress made since the last Youth Summit. He briefly reviewed the things that have been accomplished.

Councilor Villarreal suggested that he talk about the Mayor’s Youth Advisory Board and what their role is.

#### **COMMENTS FROM COUNCILOR RENEE VILLARREAL**

Councilor Villarreal did not have any comments.

#### **REPORT FROM STAFF**

Mr. Sanchez noted that the next group meeting will be next Thursday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, a day before the Youth Summit. The meeting will be from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. at the Monica Roybal Center. All Members are encouraged to attend.

## **MATTERS FROM THE FLOOR**


There were no matters from the floor.


