1. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Public Works/CIP & Land Use Committee was called to order on the above date by Councilor Peter Ives, Chair at approximately 5:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers, City Hall, 200 Lincoln Avenue, Santa Fé, New Mexico.

2. ROLL CALL

Councilor Trujillo asked Mr. Quintana if that money is to be reallocated.

Mr. Quintana said the balance was money that was originally budgeted with the project and was not spent. It will just be added to the Purchase Orders.

Councilor Trujillo found out recently that there were no weed barriers included and wondered why. No one seemed to have an answer for him.

Mr. Quintana said that decision was made by Parks after the contract was awarded. The barrier was originally in the plans.

Councilor Trujillo said that was unfortunate. He didn't know why Parks took it out. He thought it would become a disaster. That is all.

MOTION: Councilor Trujillo moved to approve the request. Councilor Villarreal seconded the motion.

Councilor Villarreal was trying to recall the section he was talking about. She thought the majority of medians that were constructed had brick at the top of the landscape.

Mr. Quintana said seven medians were with brick but there is landscaping there, as well.

Chair Ives asked if the City is doing work on the side of the road in areas where businesses were to be responsible.

Mr. Quintana clarified that all of it is within the public right-of-way and is the responsibility of the City.

Chair Ives surmised that the existing fund balance was carried over because not all of it could be done.

Mr. Quintana agreed.

The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

DISCUSSION AGENDA

10. UPDATE FROM STAFF ON POTHOLE AND ~~WEED~~ ISSUES (DAVID CATANACH /RICHARD THOMPSON)

Mr. Catanach reported on the potholes.

Chair Ives said he would like this update each month through September so the Committee has an opportunity to push out information to constituents about the work done on these. Numbers would be good and track them as we go.

Mr. Catanach provided a Tracker spreadsheet to the Committee. [A copy of the spreadsheet is attached to these minutes as Exhibit 1.] He briefly explained it as a log of the complaints that come in. He said they have put 175 tons of hot mix material in them. This year was unusual because of late snowstorm and 8" of snow in April 2017. At this point, we continue to work on them with our crew in a systematic way, working our way into residential areas. We will always get more potholes after every storm as water soaks into the street cracks and crevices. When they freeze, the pavement pops up. These are mostly kept as a CRM log with a Twitter program we use to keep track now.

Even though it says approved or not approved, once logged in, it will say approved and is in the CRM.

Mr. Catanach said that this year they have had fewer liability complaints but the late storm dragged the crew later into the year. Also, with fewer personnel, it took longer. But we are at a manageable point and are getting calls each day and respond as quickly as possible.

Councilor Trujillo recalled the City agreed to fill them within 72 hours.

Mr. Catanach agreed and his crew is doing that although some must be handled by the on-call contract. City Staff take care of all the smaller ones.

Councilor Trujillo asked if the City is getting help from DOT on Cerrillos, St. Francis and St. Michael's.

Mr. Catanach agreed.

Councilor Trujillo said the City gets lots of calls for potholes on St. Michael's and he knew we are going out on our own to patch some of them.

Mr. Catanach said those might not meet the 72-hour deadline.

Councilor Trujillo noted a huge depression on Siringo Road where it was just paved. The contractor needs to fix that.

Mr. Catanach said he will be fined about \$30,000 for what he cut up. It might have been from a gas line where he had already paved.

Councilor Trujillo expressed his gratitude from what the crew was doing. The people of Santa Fe have seen that good response.

Councilor Villarreal - thanked him as well and was sending an email to him for a problem to look into.

Chair Ives pointed out on the handout the abbreviation "QPR" and asked what it meant.

Mr. Catanach said QPR is bagged asphalt that sometimes is more convenient than waiting for hot mix. It works well for smaller potholes. We want to cut the time as much as possible and with QPR, we don't have to wait in line at the hot mix plant with other contractors. We also get bulk cold mix we store for later use.

Chair Ives asked what green patch is.

Mr. Catanach said it is recycled roof shingles and when cracking is shallow, that provides a waterproof surface. It seems to be holding up well although nothing is perfect.

Chair Ives noted on quantity shown on page 13 of 24 at bottom.

Mr. Catanach acknowledged it is impossible to quantify each small pothole.

Chair Ives said he would love to see how many calls came in, from where they came, and how many potholes were fixed with breakdown of which were done by City staff and which by on-call work. That way we can see the good work you are doing and get that message out to the citizens that the City is taking care of them.

Mr. Catanach said it is hard to provide all of that. Those calls come from all directions. We are trying to get it all done and he would do his best to quantify them.

Chair Ives hoped for a similar report next month.

Councilor Trujillo mentioned the issues at Franklin Miles Park -

Mr. Catanach said he had that on their radar.

Councilor Trujillo said it is a huge cavity there.

Chair Ives asked for the weight of the QPR bags.

Mr. Catanach said they weigh 55 lbs. The bulk of the weight comes from the hot mix - but sometimes is not available to us.

Chair Ives thanked him and asked again to get numbers on complaints.

11. PRESENTATION AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING LAND USE & URBAN DESIGN STUDY (REED LIMING)

Mr. Liming presented the study. He noted that at the last meeting, he briefed the Committee on the Long Range Plan work with the LRP Subcommittee and was invited back to present the draft document. He previously emailed the color version to the members.

He shared how the plan is organized. He showed the current General Plan from 1999 - an expensive \$500,000 document. And what the consultant left was twice this size that Staff cut down. Our Development Code is 500 pages so a 300 page LRP on top, makes it lengthy.

He said he would try to talk the Governing Body out of going with a big consultant company because he didn't believe it would be worth the expense and would be lack of use. In working on the Urban Design study, we want it to be less the kitchen sink. When you go through it, you can see with the table of contents each of the seven policy statements from the charter and the twelve themes from the General Plan. The Committee thought both were important.

Mr. Liming summarized each of the chapters for the Committee. He noted that this has not gone to the Planning Commission yet and it has gone through several iterations. We are proud of it and tried to make it more graphic and colorful instead of an endless text. Now they are ready to go however they are directed.

Chair Ives said the pagination on the index needs to be adjusted as it didn't keep pace with changes in the document. The Governing Body adopted strategic planning principles and he didn't see any of that referenced in here. That might be worth incorporating. For him, building community is a big deal. He would love to see something in here that focuses on that concept - a principle to guide our effort - pushing toward more mixed use, healthier lifestyles, conveniences nearby, with places to meet and talk.

He wanted Mr. Liming to include the strategic principles; take it to the Planning Commission for comment; give the Committee a refresher on the General Plan; and focus on where we still need to improve for urban design. This is a very timely effort and we want to work with you to move it forward and engage the population into it.

Councilor Villarreal thanked Mr. Liming for this. She appreciated the demographics and direction for the future. She was curious if the population could have a breakout with smaller age groupings.

Mr. Liming agreed they could break it down further.

Councilor Villarreal noticed there was no gender breakdown either.

She asked if the recommendations at the end correspond to the CIP list.

Mr. Liming said it starts with the ICIP (impact fees) There is a broad list from very small to very large. We are focusing just on capital improvements. We looked at SWAN, Las Soleras and South Meadows Parks.

Councilor Villarreal asked if there is a way to connect it with impact fees.

Mr. Liming said it shows two fire stations to be built and about what they would cost. It is a little blending but they consciously stayed away from it.

Councilor Villarreal thought it needs to be integrated.

Mr. Liming hoped those impact fees would show up in other ways.

Councilor Villarreal asked about the Affordable Housing Plan.

Mr. Liming said these were worked out with Staff.

Councilor Villarreal was okay with that as long as they correspond. She asked if the MPO was in there as well.

Mr. Liming agreed.

Councilor Villarreal asked if it mentioned some areas still needing to be addressed - what should occur in various places.

Mr. Liming agreed. Some is shown in the Center and Corridors map on some level of infill and what is appropriate infill. It is difficult to nail them down and have specific wording that everyone will agree to, but they tried to do their best in that map.

Councilor Villarreal asked if Council could get a larger version in color.

Mr. Liming agreed.

Councilor Trujillo said this is good. He noted Mr. Liming said they measure priorities on how many people show up. It has always been a battle to balance that.

Mr. Liming agreed. Infill will always be a touchy issue and he didn't know any great way to handle that. It does exist and is evident in the Future Land Use map and shows where change is happening.

Councilor Trujillo said, "I want to encourage businesses to come to Santa Fe and I hear people tell me they are through trying to live here." This is a nice report.

Chair Ives asked how they would evaluate the feedback received.

Mr. Liming said the next step is to try to get it in front of the Planning Commission to get their direction. Everyone has a little different outlook on what it should say.

12. PRESENTATION AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF TO ADDRESS ISSUES RELATING TO UNSAFE AND/OR ABANDONED BUILDINGS (LISA MARTÍNEZ / NOAH BERKE/ALFRED WALKER)

Ms. Martínez referenced a national organization to find solutions for abandoned homes across the country, whether residential, commercial or industrial. These properties meet the definition of public nuisance or they fail to pay taxes, utility bills and mortgages. They are a curse to the city and for anyone who lives next to them. People complain quite regularly on how to address the issues. There are usually huge expenses related to them and we can't always deal with them but it falls to Public Works, Legal, and Police. In doing research, Austin found that in those areas, there are three times as many drug calls, twice the number of violence calls. Most fires are the result of arson. There are huge chunks just for demolition and cleaning up littered lots. It results in loss in property values.

There are some options to look at. A program in Richmond called Neighborhood in Bloom, focuses on derelict neighborhoods and their work has lowered crime significantly. Multiple stakeholders meet together and they saw a ton of success with a 19% reduction in crime. There are so many steps involved. Larry Barker did a story on a vacant property here that was in foreclosure. Banks don't always clean up those properties.

Mr. Berke said he researched various ordinances for what others are doing with this problem. Quite a few New Mexico cities have undertaken a process. Chair Ives had forwarded information on the most recent one - a program in Albuquerque. They all require that these properties be registered with the City in order to keep track of it. Denver imposes a hefty fine which can be as much as \$999/day. Their ordinance requires a remedial plan. On our books in 2005, a resolution was passed by Council to that established the steps and gave the City the ability to investigate properties and make determinations and issue notices of violations. The outline for removal of such structures should be in the packet. It is a resolution; not an ordinance. If the property owner cannot prepare a plan to be brought up to satisfactory levels, next is to take it to court who sends it back to Council for a resolution to remove the property and through code enforcement, is either demolished or a public hearing is held.

In the packet was also a statement on what can be done under a nuisance abatement. We are working with police to secure such a property in Santa Fe. He shared a summary of the City Attorney's letter for taking legal action. Neighbors ask why they need to be the vigilantes. The reason is because the City has a limited number of staff for inspection, legal action, etc. but they are working together

to tackle the problem. The Mayor could introduce an ordinance similar to other cities in New Mexico to address the problem.

The Santa Fe Reporter did a recent article on some of the derelict houses in Santa Fe including on Paseo. The neighbors don't like the way it looks.

Councilor Trujillo said he hears from constituents that this is just an excuse and he has no answers for them. He asked if the court is ever going to rule on them. He would like to have an answer for them.

He mentioned the abandoned complex at the St. Francis exit from the Interstate that has been tagged and asked how the City can get rid of this.

Ms. Martínez said she was told if it is in foreclosure, the City couldn't do anything about it. And Larry Barker asked why we had not issued a notice of violation. She was told by Legal not to do anything about it. Then Larry Barker publicized the story that Legal said we could issue notices.

We do need clear-cut directions on what we can or cannot do. They are often owned by elderly people and the children or other relatives don't help take care of the property. Sometimes, the children or neighborhood groups have gone to clean it up.

Councilor Trujillo thought the ordinance should have happened long ago.

Ms. Martínez said her sister is a land use attorney and told her about a set procedure for dealing with them for a certain number of months. It involves: send a letter to the homeowner and if no response, notices of violations are sent and if not a response, the City can do more - even to point of demolishing the property. There are strict time frames for all of it for six months to a year.

Councilor Trujillo suggested the City could clean it up and send them a bill. The neighbors would be happy. If we have abandoned buildings, some people might want to just get rid of it. I'd rather see a vacant lot that a graffiti'd old house. He hoped the City could get some of these house cleaned up and appreciate the presentation.

Councilor Villarreal asked Mr. Walker to clarify where we can intervene. We did have a success in District 1 where neighbors worked with the police and probably worked on it for four years. Drugs were involved.

Mr. Walker said there are probably as many different situations as there are numbers of houses. With foreclosure, the owner says we can't do anything and the banks say they can't do anything. The City could probably take it to court and force remediation but if the owner has no money, the City has to do it.

In 2006, in a resolution, the City went in and cleaned it up and put a lien on the property. Sometimes, that is the only way the City can get paid for it. So there are costs to the city and questions on how the city would be reimbursed. In the nuisance house, we were fortunate to have neighbors show up to court also. Some neighbors are afraid of retaliation. We were fortunate that the neighbors were willing to take that risk.

Councilor Villarreal asked what is in those ordinances of other cities that we don't have.

Mr. Berke said he didn't have a way to track all of them. In other cities, they are required to register and maintain the list. But, at what point do you declare it derelict? He talked with an 82-year-old woman living in Artesia who wants to move back to her house in Santa Fe. But the floors are gone and the roof is collapsing and it means less and less chance she could move back.

We have a resolution drafted with seven steps to get to a point where the City can demolish the house or put a lien on it. That is the main difference. He was surprised how many other cities have already passed an ordinance for registration and requirements for maintaining the property. David Rasch has a demolition by neglect tool for historic districts. The seafood restaurant on Cerrillos next to Stagecoach remained abandoned and roof and floors collapsed. Mike Purdy required them to demolish the property.

Councilor Villarreal understood. We need to upgrade the resolution to do that for safety. People want to keep homes but have no money to do it. She thought the City will get more and more of these. She offered to work with him on that effort.

Chair Ives thanked him for beginning this process. Obviously it causes concerns around the city. What we have seems unwieldy and burdensome and we could use those other resolutions here. If we had a registration required, we could identify those subject to maintaining them. And prevent them from just wasting away. The duty we have is a responsibility for homeowners is to maintain the property. A number of people have expressed interest in crafting a new way to look at the issue and try to address the problem earlier so it doesn't become a greater problem. Maybe a small task force could address the issue. Our process really needs to be reworked. It is great that Councilor Villarreal wants to help/participate. Neighborhoods in Bloom sounds like a very important way to address it. He would look forward to hearing more about that.

He agreed to get the names of those he knew are interested and share them with Ms. Martínez. With someone from Land Use and someone from Legal and maybe HPD person, a task force could work on it together for something in the next 60 days. He didn't want it to be burdensome for staff.

13. REQUEST FOR REVIEW AND POSSIBLE ACTION SITE SANTA FE APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY BANNER SIGNAGE TO PROMOTE NEW ICONIC ARCHITECTURAL LANDMARK IN SANTA FE (NICHOLAS SCHIAVO) (Anne Wrinkle)

Mr. Schiavo said the City got an application that was distributed before the meeting for placing banners on light poles. [A copy of the application is attached to these minutes as Exhibit 2.]

Mr. Schiavo noted the last time banners were approved was in 2012 for the Santa Fe 400th anniversary. David Rasch was present representing Historic Preservation. [A second document was handed out that showed the locations where they would like to place the banners. [A copy is attached to

these minutes as Exhibit 3.]

In the application, fourth page, they showed a mockup of the banner and the next page provided photos of what they would look like on the poles.

Anne Wrinkle was present to go through the application and answer questions.

Chair Ives noted the SITE opening is scheduled for October 5-8 and asked what the time line is for this promotion.

Mr. Schiavo said the request is for 30 days with banners up. They would like to start on September 1 or September 8. The request would go to Historic and then to Council. All expense for banners, brackets, and removal of banners afterward would be Site Santa Fe's expense.

Chair Ives pointed out that Council meets in two days so it won't happen then.

Mr. Schiavo agreed. It would be at the 30th of August meeting. It is not an ordinance change so no special notice is needed. Historic meets tomorrow.

Mr. Rasch was familiar with only two and banner requests and both of them required an ordinance amendment and the next HDRB meeting is second Tuesday of September.

Mr. Schiavo said Ms. Wrinkle made it clear this is not for advertising but for betterment of the community - civic advancement. He talked with Legal and it is not an advertisement so no ordinance change is needed.

Councilor Trujillo asked where SITE Santa Fe wants to put them and if it would be around St. Francis.

Mr. Rasch said they want 20 banners and 10 are within the historic district but all of them are close to SITE Santa Fe.

Councilor Trujillo thought they should be throughout the City, and not exclude other parts of town.

Mr. Schiavo understood they would be willing to put them throughout the City but didn't want to impose on others.

Chair Ives asked Ms. Wrinkle to explain the plans for the banners. In any city he went to, the banners are well displayed for events at museums and a whole host of things.

Ms. Wrinkle said they have been four years in the planning and one year in construction to upgrade the old Coors beer warehouse for a mixed use auditorium and to open up the front lobby. A glass wall on the front will illustrate our activities daily and it will include an exhibition space, coffee and snack bar and a "hang out space" all open to the public before coming into the exhibition space. We are really excited to offer it to the community. Sharp Architects in NYC designed it as their first museum. New lobby hours are

7 days per week. It will be free for offering all of these assets.

This new form will offer a new destination for art around the country and we want to share it with the rest of the City. We want to raise awareness with the banners. We would love to have the banners along Cerrillos and St. Francis. From the 400th event, many brackets already exist and there are probably 20 of them. So we were thinking just to use what is there already. The lamp posts were never outfitted with bottom brackets. The Design Committee loved the proposal. It is a very pedestrian area. The third area is along St. Francis and there are 6-8 brackets there.

Councilor Trujillo said he loved the idea. Sometimes we have portions of the City that don't get their awareness raised.

Ms. Wrinkle said they just put up a billboard on the interstate.

Councilor Trujillo hoped this could start a trend. He has also seen those banners in other communities. He would like to see them at July 4th or in honoring our heroes. He wished her the best of luck.

Councilor Villarreal agreed that SITE Santa Fe does need the outreach for people to know about the opening. But she actually didn't think banners are the way to do it. The outreach has to be in a different way. She asked if DOT has jurisdiction over St. Francis or the City.

Mr. Schiavo clarified that the City has jurisdiction on the lamp posts and right around SITE Santa Fe, the Railyard Corporation has some jurisdiction.

Ms. Wrinkle said the Railyard has 27 locations but getting the bottom bracket may not happen in time. They have a board meeting tomorrow. SITE Santa Fe wouldn't need to have all 27 there.

Councilor Villarreal proposed they first go down Guadalupe to Alameda and the Railyard and St. Francis to Guadalupe. She also was encouraging them to find other ways to advertise. She supported 30 days for the length of time but noted it is a very short time line window. Whatever SITE Santa Fe could pull off with their budget, she favored and the City doesn't have to spend anything on it.

Chair Ives agreed that this is really promoting that public good rather than advertisements. He looked forward to the event. It would make Railyard space more inviting.

MOTION: Councilor Trujillo moved to approve the request with Councilor Villarreal's amendment. Councilor Villarreal seconded the motion.

Councilor Trujillo asked that they include other place in the City if they had 2-3 extra banners and to invite everyone from all parts of the City.

Chair Ives added that wherever brackets do exist on Guadalupe, at the Railyard and on Cerrillos Road would be okay.

The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

14. MATTERS FROM STAFF

Mr. Schiavo recommended not meeting on August 28th because of the special Council meeting on potential merger of NCRTD with Santa Fe Trails.

Chair Ives agreed. That would mean the next meeting would be set for September 11 with a presentation of the Airport Master Plan in lieu of a second meeting in August.

15. MATTERS FROM THE COMMITTEE

Councilor Trujillo received a call from Kiwanis and the Fire Marshal about a dilemma. Now that we are cutting all the weeds. Now we can't find any for burning at Zozobra. He would like to see if there is a bin somewhere he could go to get the weeds that are cut.

Mr. Schiavo agreed to talk with Rob Carter tomorrow for storing them somewhere.

Councilor Trujillo was very pleased with the weed cutting.

Councilor Trujillo commented about the tribute to Jerry Hicks, who passed away. That is a model for what the medians could look like.

He asked for a communication with the parks workers to pick up trash before using the lawn mowers. They cut up and spread the trash around.

Mr. Schiavo agreed.

16. MATTERS FROM THE CHAIR

Chair Ives said we've had conversation about website pages including links to all of our plan documents -that would be very helpful and especially for the PWC to have a referral spot. He liked what was presented on the link to the CIP projects at Finance last week by Mr. Pacheco. The City could let people know they can go to a specific page to see the projects being worked on and see the backup information - that supports our transparency in the City.

He announced that the Airport plans will be presented at the first meeting in September and asked if the agenda also has Department plans in the 20 year CIP process.


Mr. Schiavo thought both could be done at that meeting.



Who: SITE Santa Fe, the Southwest's leading contemporary art center
WHAT: A Street Banner Proposal to promote the opening of SITE's new building
WHEN: 30-60 Days during August – October 2017, prior to and during opening
Oct. 5-8, 2017

On behalf of **SITE Santa Fe**, I write to submit an application to install approximately 20-40 rectangular banners, approximately 2 x 4 ft, on the lampposts in several prime areas in Santa Fe to enhance civic pride, beautify the streetscapes, and build recognition of one of the city's greatest cultural assets, the Southwest's leading contemporary art center on the eve of its reopening of its expanded design by the world renowned firm **SHoP Architects**.

SITE Santa Fe is the Southwest's leading contemporary art center and we are undergoing a major building expansion to showcase the best in contemporary art and culture to the Santa Fe Community and draw arts enthusiasts from around the world to Santa Fe. As we are promoting the reopening one of Santa Fe's major cultural institutions, I am confident that the City would join us in supporting awareness and build civic engagement for what's likely to become a major destination museum in NM.

SITE Santa Fe opens its building Oct 5-8, 2017 and would like to do an awareness campaign through the use of banners on street lampposts in key traffic areas in our neighborhood to celebrate the reopening one of Santa Fe's major cultural institutions. We believe this banner installation will be a festive, beautiful, and colorful experience for our community and visitors alike, and will herald the coming opening of our new iconic, architecturally significant building.

Charlotte Jackson used the lampposts and installed temporary banners for Art Santa Fe when the event was held at El Museo for several years, and there were banners installed on many lampposts throughout this area on the occasion of the City of Santa Fe's 400th birthday in 2012.

SITE is interested in producing and installing a series of rectangular banners (approx. 2 x 3 feet) throughout the area for a temporary period of 30-60 days, to celebrate civic pride and increase awareness and excitement about our new building and programs for the community. It appears that to make this a viable initiative going forward, there might need to be some infrastructure added (for example various hanging brackets), and we could contribute to that initial set up cost.

The prospective high traffic areas that we request placement include: along the Guadalupe Street corridor from Paseo de Peralta north to San Francisco Street; in the Railyard District of Santa Fe; and along available lampposts on the St. Francis Corridor from San. Mateo through North Paseo de Peralta. We are open to creative placement in these areas, and usage of existing infrastructure installed during the City of Santa Fe's 400th birthday.

We have identified a sign company that is licensed, bonded, and has the proper equipment to install these banners. Once we know the scope of our project, we can request an estimate for the installation/de-installation.

We understand that the limit for such signage may be 30 days, and we want to get the banners into production right away so that we can have them up by early September. Our goal would be to can extend the limit in which case then we would like to install them as soon as possible to capture the August high season in Santa Fe.

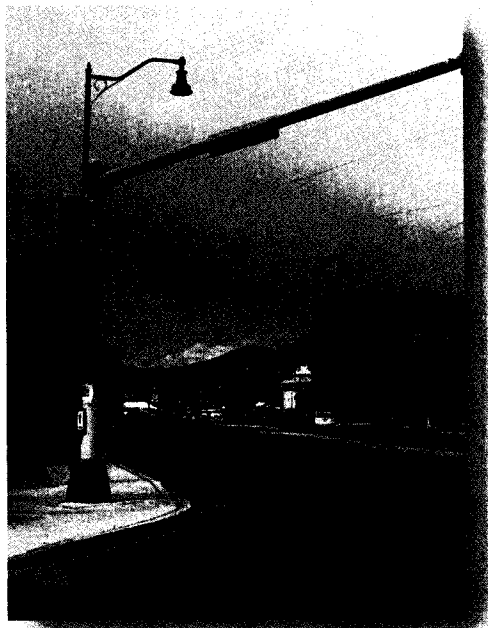
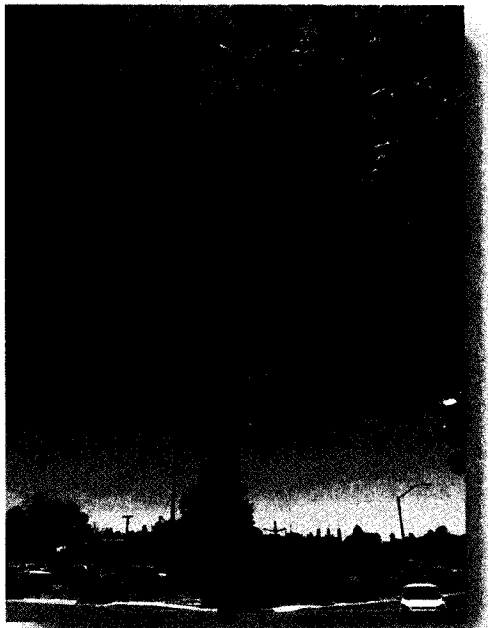

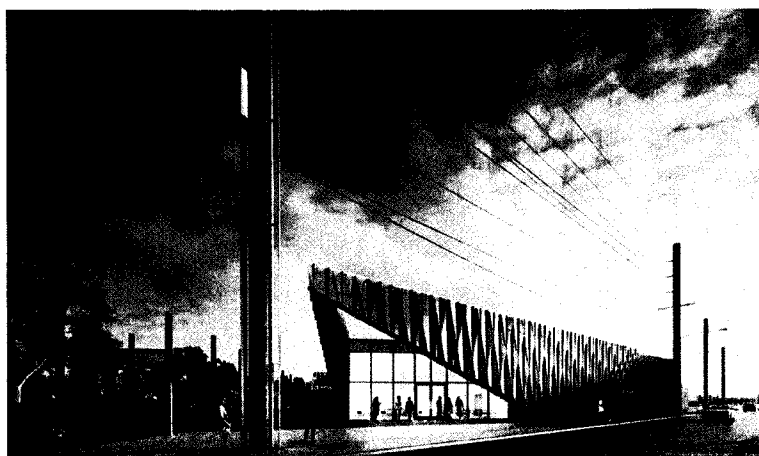
Example of Press sharing the significance of SITE's new building design by SHoP Architects.

Known for its smart international biennials as well as its prestigious residency program, SITE has tapped the New York architecture firm SHoP to add nearly 15,000 square feet to its current home and make

some crucial infrastructure improvements. The existing space, founded 20 years ago in an old Coors warehouse renovated by Richard Gluckman, is a focal point of the city's once-derelict Railyard district, but despite the industrial setting, the building always had more of a pueblo-revival feel with its low-slung adobe-type aesthetic.

While the structure has undergone some minor changes over the years, SHoP's expansion, lead by the firm's Ayumi Sugiyama, is set to bring some serious architectural clout to the institution and the city. (SHoP is also working on Uber's new headquarters in San Francisco, among other high-profile projects.) In addition to increasing space for exhibitions and education programs and installing a new auditorium, SHoP is transforming the building's unremarkable entrance into a formidable, angular prowlike form and wrapping much of the façade with a perforated aluminum sheath cleverly designed to merge the geometric patterns of Navajo blankets and the texture of the corrugated metal railcars that regularly pass by SITE on adjacent tracks. The perforations, meanwhile, will make use of the dramatic sun and shade of the high desert. Not all the stucco is disappearing: The back of the building will retain a bit of that original desert look, but the earthy pueblo-brown is becoming an industrial gray. The plan is to have a new artist create a mural on the wall with each edition of the SITE Santa Fe Biennial.

The most radical change, however, might be inside. “Five years ago we really started thinking about the limitations of the building,” says SITE director and chief curator Irene Hofmann. One problem is a lack of temperature and climate control—a serious issue in the middle of the desert, where dramatic changes in temperature and humidity are the norm. The new exhibition space will be outfitted with both HVAC and swamp coolers (which regulate humidity) to stabilize the environment. “It means we can now show a lot of art that we had not been able to bring here,” she says. Hofmann also points out that in the past, since the building had only one exhibition space, SITE had to close the gallery to visitors during the month of June—prime Santa Fe time—while installing the biennial. The addition of a 1,800-square foot SITE Lab, dedicated to rotating shows, will change that.

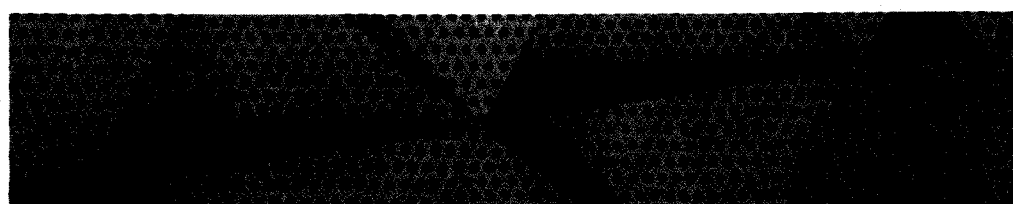
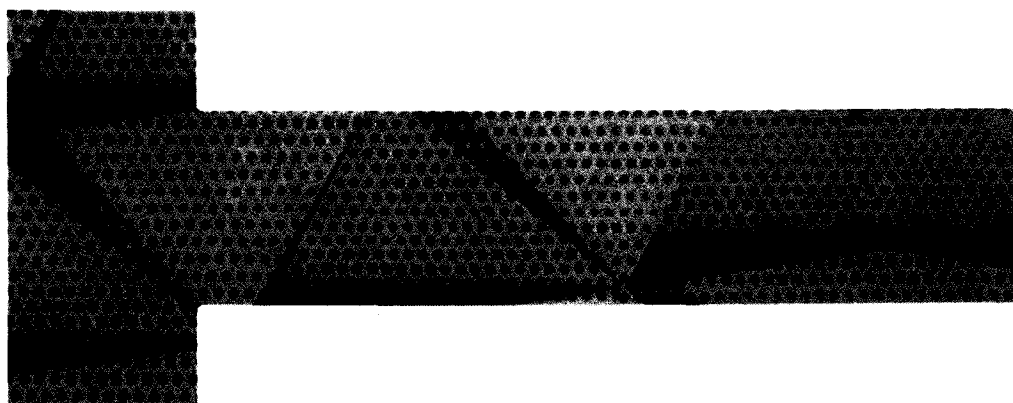
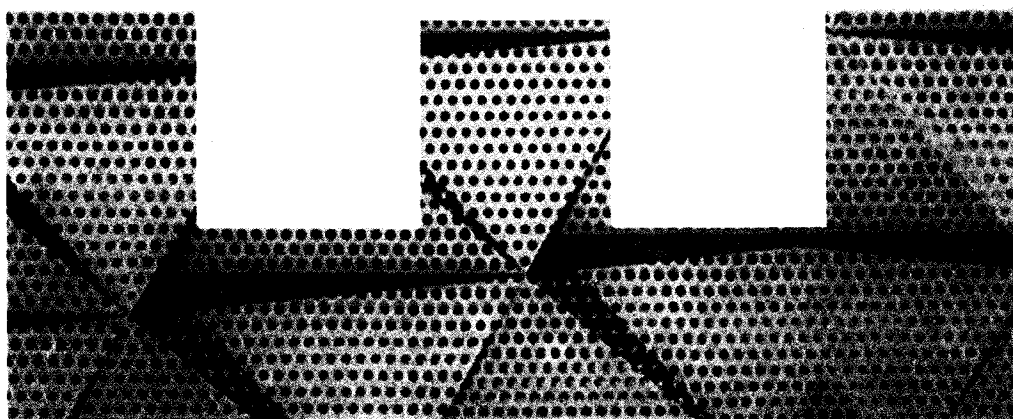

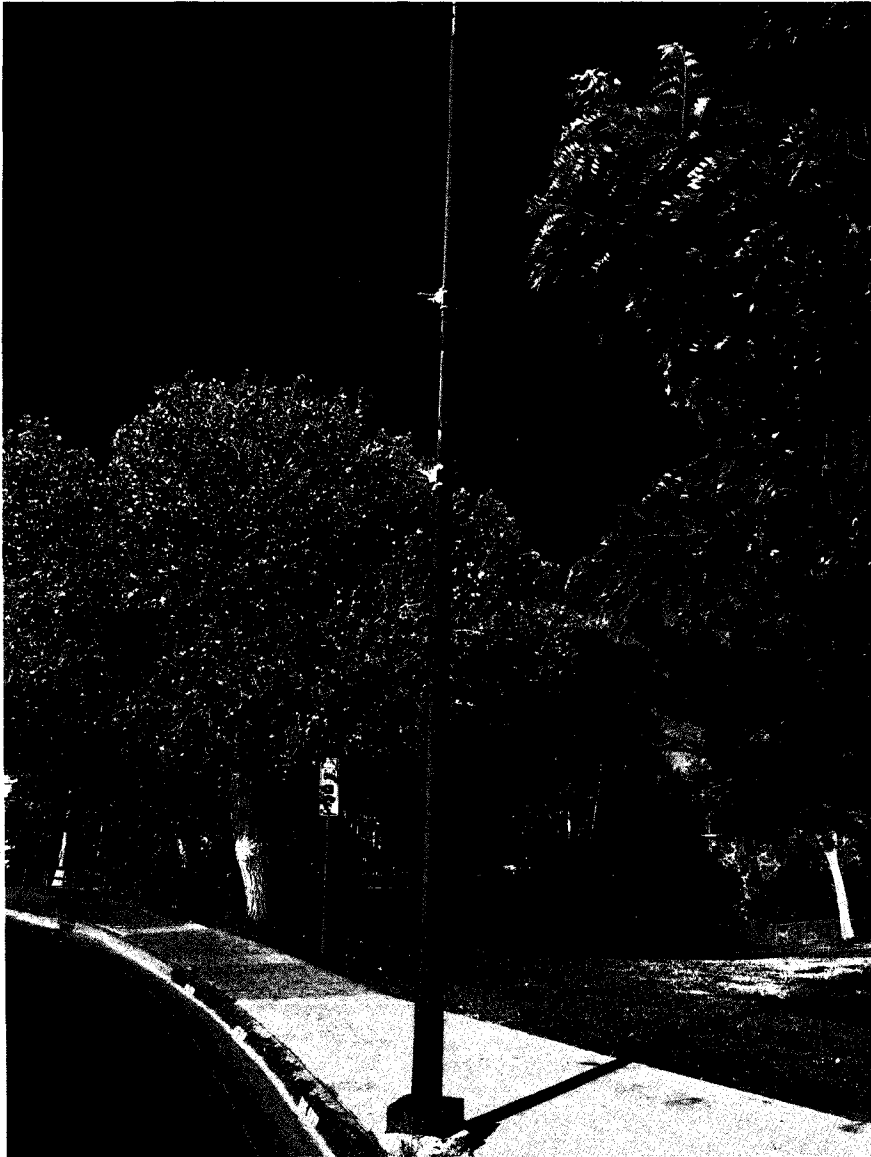

Notes from Richard Czoski, SFRCC

- 1. The actual light poles on Guadalupe Street are located outside the boundary of the Railyard proper and are outside of the area leased by SFRCC from the City of Santa Fe. Therefore the light poles on Guadalupe Street are within the City's jurisdiction.
- 2. There is only one green light pole on Paseo de Peralta from Guadalupe to Alarid Street. This light pole is located within the area SFRCC leases from the City, so the use of this light pole is within SFRCC's jurisdiction. Provided SITE Santa Fe complies with item #4 below, SFRCC would support this light pole being used for Site Santa Fe's event banner.
- 3. Having said that, SFRCC's only concern with the SITE Santa Fe request or any future request is that the light pole banners not be used by any individual or group to establish an identity or branding of the Railyard. SFRCC has worked hard over the years to establish a brand and identity for the Railyard and we would ask that SFRCC be included in any discussion regarding banners that would impact the image of the entire Railyard.
- 4. The SITE Santa Fe request is event specific and therefore would probably not impact the branding or identity. Therefore SFRCC requests that the City approves the use of the street lights for the event banners. However, SFRCC would request that the design and graphics of the banners be reviewed by the Architecture and Design Committee which is comprised of SFRCC Board members and Bob Siquieros.
- 5. SFRCC would also recommend a duration of no more than 90 days for any specific posting of banners, but there may be a City code which addresses this subject in more detail.
- 6. We appreciate SITE Santa Fe's investment in their building and the Railyard and look forward to a bright future for SITE Santa Fe's expanded programs and facilities.

We appreciate the support of the SFRCC of our project, and look forward to its guidance and input in proceeding with this proposal.

If we are to be successful in mounting this campaign, time is of the essence, and we need to move quickly forward along several tracks (design, production, fabrication and city approvals, resolutions, etc) to implement it to maximum effect.

We seek to make a request to the City of Santa Fe for the Guadalupe Street Lamp posts, as they are under its jurisdiction.

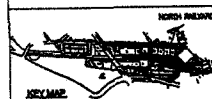

2. STREET LIGHTING SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF SANTA FE LIGHTING STANDARDS.

3. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE THE OWNER SUFFICIENT NOTICE IN ADVANCE OF TURNING ON THE SYSTEMS SO AS TO AVOID TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND APPROVE THE SYSTEMS BEFORE THEY ARE TURNED ON.

4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A LIGHT RECORD OF THE LIGHTING SYSTEM WITH THE OWNER TO ENSURE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF LIGHTING SYSTEMS.

5. EXISTING LIGHTING SHALL COMPLY WITH THE NEW MEXICO RIGHT OF WAY ACT. EXISTING LIGHTING SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN THAT ALL FIXTURES SHALL BE FULLY OPERATIONAL AND HAVE LESS THAN 20% BURNED OUT LAMP LIFE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING.

6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN FOUNDATION LOCATIONS TO PROVIDE EVIDENCE TO EXISTING FOUNDATION LINES AND OTHER UTILITIES AS REQUIRED.

7. LIGHTING STANDARDS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF SANTA FE LIGHTING STANDARDS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING.

8. LIGHTING CIRCUITS SHALL BE TAKEN AT THE CONTROL. CABLES TO EXISTING CIRCUITS SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN THAT ALL FIXTURES SHALL BE FULLY OPERATIONAL AND HAVE LESS THAN 20% BURNED OUT LAMP LIFE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING.

9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING.

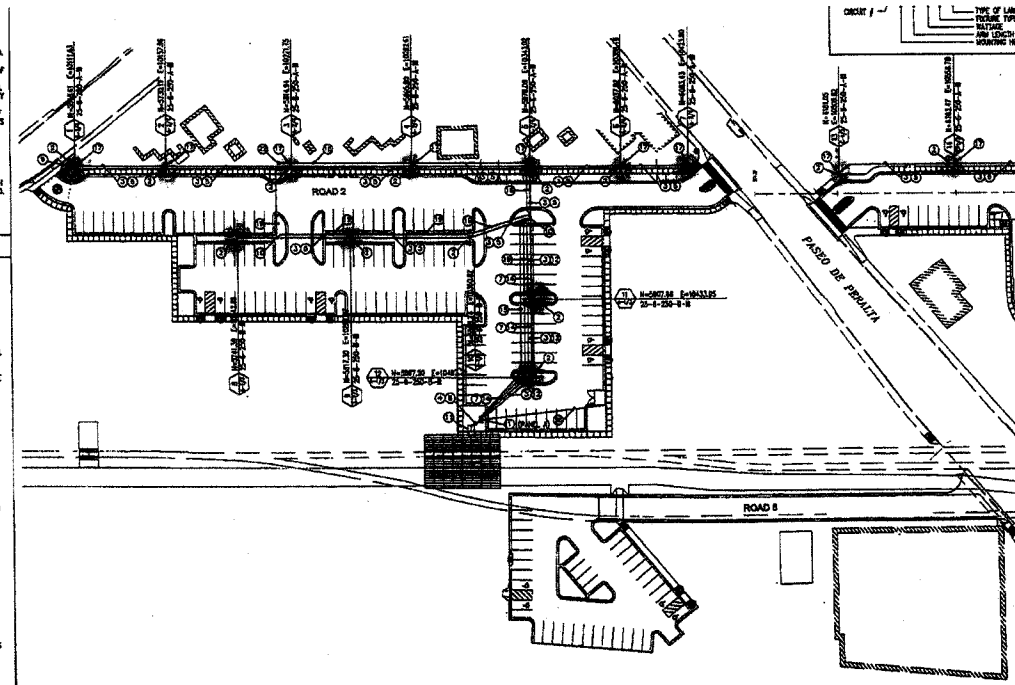

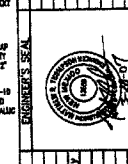
