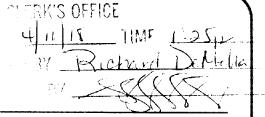

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Santa Fe Regional Juvenile Justice Board was called to order at 5:21 p.m. by Sam Jackson, Chair. A quorum was established at 5:23 p.m.

3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

MOTION: Deacon Trujillo moved to approve the agenda as presented with a second from Mr. Lindahl which passed by voice vote.

4. INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Introductions were made by those present.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM February 15, March 29 and April 5, 2018

MOTION: Mr. Lindahl moved to approve the group of minutes as presented with a second from Deacon Trujillo which passed by voice vote.

6. FINANCIAL REPORT

a. Budget- Detailed Budget and Financial FY 17/18

Mr. DeMella explained all programs have been spending the amounts down, he explained the report and the invoices that were submitted are included. (See Exhibit A)

Chair Jackson asked if there were any concerns. Mr. DeMella stated there were not any issues with line items.

Mr. Lindahl asked if Youthworks can use the monies by the end of the school year. Mr. DeMella explained that they will be able to spend it down.

Ms. Romero asked about the balance for CIS. Mr. DeMella explained, it is a very small amount and they will be able to spend it down.

b. Approve Financial Report

MOTION: Mr. Lindahl moved to approve the Financial Report as presented, with a second from Ms. Romero which passed by voice vote.

7. PRESENTATIONS

a. RFP 18/39/P

Mr. DeMella would like to meet with the program committee to review the RFP and have a board meeting before it is sent out to approve the recommendations of the program committee.

Mr. DeMella would like it scheduled so the contracts pass through the proper committees and City Council by June 1, 2018.

Mr. DeMella has a letter with the amount that will be granted by CYFD. It is the same amount as they were granted this year.

Deacon Trujillo asked if the lines items are going to be the same as they started with. Mr. DeMella explained a BAR can be approved at any time during the year if need be.

Chair Jackson would like to meet as a board rather than the program committee. Mr. DeMella proposed May 3, 2018 at an earlier time.

Mr. Lindahl excused himself from the meeting.

b. Re-engagement BAR

Mr. DeMella discussed the BARs in the packet. (Exhibit B) They were approved by CYFD. The last one turned in is still pending. Mr. DeMella explained the process of changing line items.

c. ICM BAR

Mr. DeMellla discussed this above. (See Exhibit C)

d. Multimedia approach for Board

Mr. DeMella explained that Ms. Bergen once mentioned that the Board needs to be more known in the community. Mr. DeMellla states he has a gentleman who worked on the video for the Youth Summit. Perhaps promote with a video with the youth and the members and perhaps the Governing Body.

Mr. DeMella explained prevention is a great thing to promote. The services they provide are vital to the community.

Chair Jackson explained that the selection of youth for the promotions is also important.

Ms. Bergen explained the reason she brought it up, now that she knows the work the board has done over the years. It is very powerful and the community doesn't know what they have done and the funds used for intervention.

Councilor Abeyta thinks it is important, one task they were given by the new Mayor is to visit and sit on the Committees to prove that some boards are needed. Public outreach is key and important at this time.

Chair Jackson explained the task is given is to find programs for the funds they give out. Mr. DeMella explained that the City doesn't distribute or contribute the funds. The state matches funds.

Councilor Abeyta explained he will need the Boards terms and the supporting documents. Deacon Trujillo states they need to discuss the next steps. Mr. DeMella states he will bring the media person in to present at the June meeting.

Chair Jackson states another strong way to reach the community is to attend public meetings and be speakers.

Deacon Trujillo states the conversation needs to continue.

Mr. DeMella explained the event flyer is in the packet. (See Exhibit D) It is a good family event they will march to the plaza.

Mr. DeMella met with the Don Miller who works with a horse program. He would like to put some youth in that program. Mr. DeMella states the therapy is used to calm a person around a horse. He would like it to be a pilot program.

Chair Jackson discussed a similar program he had a family member involved in.

Mr. DeMella states the gentleman will present in June.

Mr. DeMella discussed Councilor Abeytas work in the Boys and Girls Club and the help they gave with the Diners Hub and other programs. Councilor Abeyta will be a great asset to the Board.
