Councilor Harris: When we have a drawdown like this on any fund, what is the balance in your fire protection fund?

Chief Babcock stated that Asst. Chief Snyder handles the procurement balance and he is out of town. Chief will get the information to Councilor Harris.

Councilor Harris moved to approve Procurement Using Cooperative Education Services (CES) Agreement # 17-20B-C101-ALL, in the Total Amount of \$76,130.34 for a new Wildland Firefighting Support Vehicle for the Fire Department; Melloy Dodge, second by Councilor Lindell, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

b) Request for Approval of a Professional Services Agreement Utilizing Cooperative Education Services (CES) in the Amount of \$150,752.29 for Installation and Materials for Vehicle Intersection Detection Inductive Loops, Bixby Electric, Inc.

Councilor Harris: I don't want to go through the numerous intersections on the list, most of them have been recently repaved, what is the proper sequence would we normally install the induction loops first, or do they get cut in afterwards?

Regina Wheeler, Public Works: An answer not available at this time.

Councilor Harris he does not have a problem with getting the work done, he wants to make sure it is done in proper sequence.

Councilor Rivera: Are we still doing cuts in asphalt or are we using the devices that sit on top of the streetlights.

Ms. Wheeler said that it seems that Councilor Rivera knows more about this process than she at this time and isn't sure about the technology used. That may be the answer and why the sequencing is ok.

Councilor Harris asked if this has gone to Public Works; it does show that it was approved on consent.

Councilor Harris moved to approve Professional Services Agreement Utilizing Cooperative Education Services (CES) in the Amount of \$150,752.29 for Installation and Materials for Vehicle Intersection Detection Inductive Loops; Bixby Electric, Inc., second by Councilor Lindell, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

d) Request for Approval of Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER); Submitted to HUD in Compliance with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Grant; United States Department of Housing and Development. (Jacqueline Beam)

Councilor Romero-Wirth: How do you pick the targets for instance how many rental units you are going to work on, how much homeless prevention is expected vs. actual and what kind of dent does this overall work put in the problems that we have?

Ms. Beam: The CDC, which is the Commission that guides our goals as well as our targets around affordable housing, they are the committee that helps in deciding what these goals are as well as our consultant. We had a fair housing review recently done and also impediment was a part of that report and we focused on those areas in particular. As far as making a dent, we could always use more funding but we try to touch as many lives as we can with the funding we have available. At this point time those were the decisions made by the Community Development Commission (CDC) as being the best way to approach it. The report is based upon progress from the previous years of those applications that we approved for programs. Everything that you are seeing in that report is based upon the approval programs that were made from the prior year to be performed throughout FY 17.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: One of the drivers is funding? Based on the funding, is that how you figure out what you are going to be able to do.

Ms. Beam: Yes it is one of the drivers because there are criteria that we have to meet by HUD. Public Service for instance, we can only use 15% for public service. We cannot use any funding for actual brick and mortar construction, new construction but we can use it for soft costs. There are many variables that are decided on by CDC.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: It is my curiosity as in most of the cases you either met or exceeded your targets, a few of them you are under and wanted to know what this means for housing overall in terms of your work.

Alexandra Ladd: For clarification, when we do the release of notice of funding availability which is our RFP, the grantees, sub recipients will propose in summary for xx amount of dollars they can provide services for so many people, based on their application.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: In terms of the capacity of those providing services are they at their capacity to provide services or with more funding would they grow their capacity?

Ms. Beam: They never get funded the full amount that they are asking for because there just is not enough. For example, if Homewise says, with \$300,000 we could provide 10 down payment loans, then with \$100,000 they will provide 5 or 6. There is a proportional representation after a lot of the programming. Some of the homeless providers are going to have people walk through the doors whether they get \$30,000 from CDBG or \$50,000 because the need is there and the mission is to serve as many people as possible. The more money they get makes their services more comprehensive, gives them funding to be open more hours, do more outreach, whatever the need is. They are proposing based on their ideal situation or their aspirational what they would love to see.

Councilor Harris: Page 10 of 41, page 7 in the report; we didn't expend all the money, it was resources and available shows \$1.44 million CDBG and not spent \$89,000. Are there any consequences to the program or the city for not spending down the full amount for service?

Ms. Beam: Currently what happens is that this comes from program income because the resources that are totaled here include program income and HUD requires such as Homewise that they use program income before then can use CDBG funds so it leaves some in the account that goes forward to the next year.

Councilor Harris: \$1.44 million, those are CDBG funds.

Ms. Ladd: Yes, as well as program income that is generated as a result of the CDBG. The way that HUD tracks funds is by the grant year. We are reporting prior to June 30th. Some of this money will be spent before the end of FY. The only time HUD would have a concern is if you had a large amount not spent, which has not been the problem for the city of Santa Fe. Also noted is program funds have to be spent down before entitlement funds.

Councilor Harris: Is it fair to say that as of those CDBG funds that we receive, that it bridges a couple of FY's, can we put all of that money in service?

Ms. Ladd: Normally all of the money is put in to service and occasionally we will have a situation where the program will return the funds for some reason or get cancelled. Last year we closed out everything that we were carrying funds over. The main reason the programs are carrying funds over is because they are generating program income. The initial grant is called the entitlement funds. When the entitlement funds generate program income, than program income has to be spent first. Some times the entitlement funds will sit over more than 12 months.

Councilor Harris: Page 11 – My question; say Pete's Place with the new name: Resource Opportunity Center, are there any funds from the Federal Government to temper the impact on the neighborhoods or for these facilities because whether it is this

facility or others, the impact is significant to the surrounding neighborhoods. Are there ever monies available, for example; Harrison Road, we have been struggling for a while to get sidewalks and streetlights there to make it safer. Is there federal money available to temper the impact or do they expect state and local monies to cover it?

Ms. Ladd: To my knowledge I don't what they have available. Through HUD what we have is public service aspect, which is the 15% and that, can help folks connect to housing and work that would alleviate some of the things that you are talking about.

Councilor Harris: Whether it is streetlights or public safety for the number of police officers there are a number of hours that officers spend there; are there ever any monies available in a grant process to temper the impact of these facilities.

Ms. Ladd: I don't know other than the way we have chosen to use our CDBG funds, we outline the goals and the providers need to detail how the funds will be used.

Councilor Harris: I have read the report and I know what the CDBG funding is about.

Ms. Beam: It does provide public facility improvements and it can provide neighborhood revitalization and improvements. As far as it being attached directly to a homeless shelter, I think that is all possible, it would be how you word it and also we have an RFP process so it would be dependent on the CDC selection of the programs and projects for that year. As far as other federal funds I am not aware.

Councilor Harris: It is good to know; I did not know that CDBG money could be used for infrastructure adjacent to Pete's Place. Thank you.

Councilor Harris: (page 10) (Read statement) Opportunity Zones, I believe we have 5 identified opportunity zones in the city. How does this statement in terms of priority and focus, how will it be coordinated with the CDC? CDC probably has the responsibility to look at locations in projects that would be appropriate for public housing, whether CDBG is involved.

Ms. Beam: The 2018 projects have already been approved; the opportunity zone that was approved for our access funds, which \$160,000 will be allocated for the LINK, Campus area. That has been decided.

Councilor Harris: That has been decided and in the future will you look at the other zones and the properties that may be suitable?

Ms. Beam: We are looking at the potential impacts of the future and we don't know what will happen between now and 2019 when the projects come up again. However, we are looking at those opportunities, as it is a great way to leverage private partners.

Councilor Harris: Maybe if the approved guidelines for those zones are in place, last I heard they weren't understood or in place. Thank you.

Councilor Harris: Page 19 – Training; there is a lot of talk about training, can we take full advantage of it. Councilor Harris wanted to reiterate the importance of getting training from HUD and taking advantage of those benefits. Councilor Harris feels it is critical to get the training to know the new rules and any updates.

Ms. Beam: It is basically for Ms. Ladd and Ms. Beam. Ms. Beam said she just came back from training in Miami, FL.; it was a 3-day very intense training from HUD.

Councilor Harris: Page 27 of 41: Hours and the cost reimbursable from the CDBG Grant. (Ref: Page 3 – PR26 CDBG Financial Summary Report) – Are these the dollars that are allowed by CDBG for grant administration?

Ms. Beam: We allotted 20% of the total for administration and we were within that range.

Councilor Harris asked if she knew the total amount. How much does it cost the city to administer this program?

Ms. Ladd: This year was a heavy commitment of staff time for CDBG grant and process because we Jacqueline was new and she had to do trainings which are always time consuming, new knowledge transfer and we also did 2 Fair Housing Study's as well as the 5-year consolidated plan in addition to the regular reporting and planning processes. This year was really skewed. I would say in past years we have not been too far off, we have a contract administrator who pushes all the contracts through and handles all the invoices and she gets paid 40% out of admin line item and Ms. Beam is at 60% out of admin line item and they did pay consultant this year.

Councilor Harris moved to approve Professional Services Agreement Utilizing Cooperative Education Services (CES) in the Amount of \$150,752.29 for Installation and Materials for Vehicle Intersection Detection Inductive Loops; Bixby Electric, Inc., second by Councilor Romero-Wirth, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

7. INFORMATIONAL

a) City Owned Assets. (Matt O'Reilly)

Chair brought this item up in order to review the properties to prioritize any changes. Chair would also like to see the resolution or ordinance in process of disposing properties. His intentions are to have the discussion to consider should there be a future recession and the importance of having money. The Chair would like Ms. O'Reilly's recommendation of what he would recommend disposing of in the future.

Chair Abeyta commented that he is pleased to see that there is a list of real property for the city. The Chairs intention is to open up dialogue with the staff regarding properties that the City may want to dispose of in the near future because they are just there, they may be outdated, or for whatever reasons we may want to look at. The

Chair asked Ms. McCoy for a copy of the Resolution related to the disposal of property. I believe the existing Resolution or Ordinance talks about the money going in to an Economic Development fund and is not sure if that is the direction that the Council would want to stay with. The Chair said his thoughts are if there is a possible recession in the future, we should have more cash on hand and obviously the time to sell property is not when you are in the middle of a recession. The Chair said these are his intentions and he opens it up for dialogue with the Finance Committee members. As a follow-up, he would ask for a recommendation to staff from the Finance Committee or a suggestion from Staff and Mr. O'Reilly (before he leaves), of property that should be flagged for disposal and 1 or 2 sentences as to why that would be recommended.

Mr. O'Reilly: (Exhibit A) is Real Property Inventory. This is a list of real property that are discreet properties that can be described. The city owns 8,638 acres with multiple parcels. Mr. O'Reilly explained different restrictions on some of the property. There are properties that are discreet properties that can be defined in the plat or deed. People ask me how does the city get all this property and the best way I have answered it is; that often the city properties have become ours. That doesn't mean we actively went our and purchased property, that is actually very rare we would do that. Often times property is deeded to us for open space, sometimes we receive patents for property for example the entire MRC came in to the city by the BLM for a specific purpose under a BLM patent which also means we are restricted o how we can use it. We can't go off and sell property in the MRC. The same thing goes for property that has been set aside for open space, some times on plats in subdivisions for projects that are approved. Sometimes someone will give us property and sometimes we actually acquire properties and sometimes properties are restricted on their use by those plats or deeds. What isn't included in this list are things like the land that we own on to our streets, this does not include streets, this is just distinct parcels of right of way. Also not included in this list are areas of where we have less than full property rights, less than 100% of fee simple ownership of property. We have a number of easements on private property for sewer lines, etc., that give us interest to the real property but we do not own them. Also not listed are small parcels that we don't know about. What I mean by that is this committee and the Council as a whole has seen us bring forward to the Council is approval of a sale or lease of what we call a remnant parcels. These are small slivers of land that have been left over when we maybe acquired many years ago a right of way. They could be anywhere from 200 to 2000 sq. ft. These are parcels that don't always shows up as distinct parcels on plats. In the late 1960's when St. Francis Dr. was built and they tore through those properties in that area, a lot of right of way was acquired to make that happen. When that happens the city or state acquires the property needed for the roads but they don't always acquire just the width of the right of way. Those are areas that are hard to track. In terms of what property we want to sell, we are restricted on some of these properties; we can't just sell the MRC, we can't just sell Sun Mountain as an example nor would we want to in my opinion. The list of properties that we own inside of the city limits that are discreet and buildable and are sufficient size and that we aren't using for something are very small. We have some

small parcels along Alto Street and we did affordable housing development that could be sold. We also brought forth some parcels on Richards Ave. right of way that never happened because we built the bridge across the river at Siler instead. There was one property in there were we purchased almost the entire property and we bought the whole thing so we have a lot there that could be sold. Last year we brought forward a list of potential parcels that could be sold as part of a Resolution sponsored by Councilor Ives about property that we could potentially make available for affordable housing purposes. Those are parcels that if we wanted to, we could sell or gift to an affordable housing developer. The function of our office when it was set up was to make property available, not only generate revenue for the city, but also to leverage the property to accomplish city goals and as we know some of those goals are affordable housing. How much do we want to sell and which parcels we might want to sell depends on how aggressive we want to be and how much do we want to weigh the short term cash we would get from a property and what it would do for us in providing for affordable housing. Certainly as an example the Siler Rd. parcel where the Arts and Creativity Center was proposed. The last time I looked at the appraisal it was at \$1.3 million dollars and I'm sure we could sell that and if we were lucky we might get \$1.3 million dollars for it or we could provide it for affordable housing and not take the cash. The goal is to create a rainy day fund or possible coming recession, but we have a dire need for housing in the city. Generally, our office has focused not so much on selling property, and there are pieces of land that are saleable and we would get a favorable amount. We have focused more on leasing property and part of the reason we focused on leasing property is part of what you alluded to Mr. Chair is, as you know generally our revenue streams in the city are troubling since most of our revenue comes from gross receipts taxes as opposed to property taxes and the in the same sense rather than selling a property, particularly if a property is not worth that much on a saleable basis, we look to rent it to create a continuing stream of revenue that currently goes roughly 50% to Economic Development fund per the ordinance you referred to, Chapter 11-14 of the Municipal Code and the other 50% goes to a variety of enterprise funds who control those parcels. The Council may want to consider this as well on whether we want to sell off property or put it away or just continue to focus more on leasing to create a reliable stream of revenue.

Councilor Harris: Clarity, 2nd page, 44 & 45 – shows 2,000 acres for the airport and 20 acres for the Waste Water Treatment Plant. It was my understanding that the Waste Water Treatment Plant or most of it is on Airport property. What is the relationship between these two line items? Is there 20 acres that is outside the airport property?

Mr. O'Reilly: I am not sure. You are right that the balance or majority of the Waste Water Treatment Plant is technically on Airport Property. Technically when this was put together, I'm not sure that the relatively recent issue about it being on Airport property or not had come to the floor. We can research that or find out.

Councilor Harris: The Senior Engineer from the Dallas FAA office was on site this week to look at whether or not this property can be disposed of or is it essential to

airport operations. Mr. Baca, Airport Manager will work with them. We have an appraisal a little over one year old from Ms. Alcott. My next question; let's say we have an affirmative decision from FAA that we can dispose of this land, is it necessary if it is an internal transaction to have an updated appraisal?

Mr. O'Reilly: No.

Councilor Harris: I didn't think so but I see Ms. McCoy nodding in the affirmative.

Mr. O' Reilly: I respectfully disagree. We are not the state and the things that are under discussion now with my understanding is that we are considering having the Waste Water Division enter in to an inter-departmental transfer and then possibly paying off the sale price over time.

Councilor Harris stated that those are the preferred terms.

Mr. O'Reilly continued that he thinks honestly that if the appraisal is only 1 year old, there will not be a significant difference from what someone appraised before and what they appraised 12 months later. You can make the argument that if the parcel is going to be paid for overtime, that the value of the parcel changes over the 3-years that you are paying it off. I think we can tie ourselves in knots over things like this since it is an inter-governmental transfer. It is all going to be owned by the city. If they asked me if I was still the Development Director of the City, I would tell the Airport not to get a new appraisal.

Councilor Harris thanked Mr. O'Reilly as he values his opinion. Where is the list of developable properties that you generated over a year ago?

Mr. O'Reilly said that list is still available and CDC is evaluating.

Councilor Harris wanted to make sure the list is still available because CDC was supposed to be evaluating city properties that would be available for projects. If they are working that, the answer is sufficient. Additional question: Line Item 227 – School Site B - Montoya's 15 acres, administered by Housing and Development.

Mr. O'Reilly: When the Northwest Quadrant was being planned over 10 years ago, this parcel was located within the master plan area what was to be the Northwest Quadrant Development. This was in deed a parcel that was owned by the public school system. Not sure of the reasoning at the time, but the city thought correct to buy the partial of land prior to getting the Northwest Quadrant Master Plan in place and as the committee knows, didn't happen. We now own a land locked piece of land that we paid over \$800,000 for and I can't do anything with it unless it became a bigger part of the Northwest Quadrant. This parcel is not currently developable as it sits as a separate parcel.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: If you took out things that we are using and are important to us likes parks, Sun Mountain how much acreage would be there?

Mr. O'Reilly: The list my office prepared last year, it would be a smaller list than this. As you can see there are larger parcels in the Upper Watershed and areas we have never touched. In terms of what we could sell that would be saleable, I would guess its not very much. If we took the approach that we were going to sell land off in and around the Santa Fe University of Art Design Campus, or the land on Siler Road it could get in to the 20-40 acres of land we could sell if that is what we wanted to do. In terms of the land that isn't allocated and is developable it might be 15-20 acres that is developable and could be sold. That includes an unrestricted parcel near Ragel Park, an unrestricted parcel on Calle Mejia, unrestricted parcel near Monica Lucero park; things like that. Surprising there are only small amounts of parcels that we could sell but if we did sell, especially if we chose to re-zone it before we sold the parcels we could make more money if we wanted to. There isn't as much as everyone thinks.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: With a cost benefit analysis is it going to be beneficial to sell. Is there better use for future property, we should review before we regret it later.

Mr. O'Reilly: Some of the parcels we identified last year are parcels that have sat completely in no use for 40-50 years and unlikely that we would find a use for all of them. With that said, we are never sure of all things. The idea of selling off some of these parcels would work best if they were combined with other cost saving measures that could assist us for in a recession. The consolidation of our facility services and some of our building, and I know that this committee and this Council have talked about this for a long time. This would do a number of things, drastically reduce the burden on our Facilities Division and staff but also the money that is spent on maintaining 50 different HVAC systems, ability to keep our staff in one consolidate location so we aren't spending money on gasoline, car parts and driving back and forth and pumping all that extra carbon in to the air. The money that we could garner by moving out of several buildings and we could lease or sell. Buildings that we talk about are like 801 San Mateo - the Water Division Building, the power condominiums at Market Station, buildings like that, our entire Siringo complex most likely could be consolidated. The amount of energy we could save if we combined all these parcels and if we had a modern efficient building where we all worked.

Councilor Romero-Wirth: That sound more exciting than where we started. Some of these vacant land pieces I wonder about future water potential or being able to drill wells that might serve the city. Is that a viable thing to think about? Vacant land may not seem viable but put a well on it might change the circumstances.

Mr. O'Reilly: If Mr. Marcos Martinez would be here, he would say don't do that. The reason for that is it is a long and tedious process in converting those water rights in to municipal use.

Councilor Rivera: All these numbers refer to a map number, is there a place on the website to view a map?

Mr. O'Reilly said the map # is an internal number that his department used, they were maintaining a map. The most important number in locating these parcels is the TaxAcct/UPC number. When using that number, staff could then pull up a map. Mr. O'Reilly said if it's the Finance Committee member's would like a map he can have the GIS Department do so.

Councilor Rivera: Confirmed it would be very helpful.

Question on Parcel: 194-197-198, a couple of example of streets.

Mr. O'Reilly: Stated that he believes these are portions of street right of way that are outside the actual right of way of the street.

Councilor Rivera asked if these are the parcels that we usually sell back to the adjacent homeowner.

Mr. O'Reilly: That is true and also the parcel main is a name that we have assigned, it is not an official name it is just our way of tracking what these are. It could be that it is not actually part of the street; it is just a parcel that is along Buffalo Grass road.

Councilor Rivera: This is a lot of information but I did see the property along Siler Road not what we currently have, not sure if it is the Henry Lynch address, Siler or Alto?

Mr. O'Reilly: I am pretty sure it is on here Councilor.

Councilor Rivera: The property that is adjacent to the city yards is that a Siler Road address?

Mr. O'Reilly: I'm not sure how it is listed on this particular list here. The City yard parcel #34 is 40 acres and there is another parcel that is 14 acres, which is the parcel right behind it and should be listed separately. The total we own in Siler Rd. corporate area is about 54 acres.

Councilor Rivera: #173 – State Police Headquarters, is all that property they sit on City property?

Mr. O'Reilly: Yes it is. We did a great deal with the state in 1968 where we gave the State Police the use of that property for \$1. That lease that they have runs until 2068. Some of the members are aware some of the things we were working on last year was trying to do a swap with the state of NM for some property in and around the University of Art Design. This property, 36 acres was part of that proposed transaction. We proposed to deed that property to the state in exchange for the state deeding to us 10 individual parcels of other property for equal value. The reason for

that is because the state controls this property until 2068 and we didn't anticipate throwing the state police off of this property so we saw it as a good way of leveraging something that they wanted with something that we wanted which was to get more control of the land in and around the university and other places in the city. A long way of saying yes, that 36 acres is owned by the city and the State Police is using it.

The Chair stated that basically everything we said this last hour, maybe there should be a strategic plan or master plan, I don't know if we do an RFP or if that is going to be a future direction of the Asset Department or there may be properties we need to consolidate or dispose of. We have had properties for 40-50 years; I would like to see something like that happen. I think the discussion was helpful today when we look at the properties that we have assets for the city.

Mayor Webber: Thank you to Mr. O'Reilly for all the work he has done for the city. It is also true, and we talked about this at budget time, how do we get the city's capital assets under control and what does it mean in terms of our operating expenses to be spread out so much across so many different buildings with so little consolidation and whether it is individuals trying to work with the city and have us be their helpful agents or people who work for the city doing a better job. We certainly have made it very difficult to have people do that in a very effective and efficient way. We have a lot of property and a lot of buildings. As I walked in and heard your comments, Mr. Chairman, I think you are exactly right. There is work to be done and we could make this more coherent and use our assets smarter and get rid of the ones that aren't useful and consolidate what we want in a more productive way. We would save a lot of money and be a more productive and operative city to interact with. Thank you for your request and for bringing this to the finance committee and moving in to larger conversations, you are doing exactly the right thing.

8. MATTERS FROM STAFF

Ms. Wheeler: In response to the Induction question. We are installing inductors in proper sequence but it does require cutting in to the pavement because it can only be 1" deep in to the asphalt. You can't do it before you paint the road and you can't do it after you paint the road. We did try the pole mounted systems but there were intermittent and they have to be adjusted constantly and they have an inconsistent performance are very expensive. We returned back to a reliable and affordable process of cutting in to pavement induction systems and we do add an extra amount of tar to the pavement of asphalt where we repave so it doesn't cause bumps and degradation of pavement.

Mary McCoy: We have provided answers from previous meeting: 4 packets for your review and we are continuing to work diligently to get answers for the other questions.

Councilor Rivera:

<u>Budget Salary</u> or Actual Salary

Do the statements come from the actual department or other departments used to cover the cost where they were needed?

Brad Fluetsch: We are only 2 months in to the new FY at this point in time so this is going to be savings above and beyond the vacancy credit that was used in the budget. We have yet to realize all of those savings or identify them.

Councilor Rivera: Are there vacancy savings?

Brad Fluetsch: Yes, there are vacancy savings and we incorporate that in to the budget? For the last 2 years we have also had vacancy savings in excess of the vacancy saving credit. The first place those funds would come from is within the department and the division; it would come out of their budget and their salary line item. After that if there are not sufficient funs we would look elsewhere.

Councilor Rivera: Since the City Managers office is small where do those savings come from?

Brad Fluetsch: It would come from his division and then it would come from the general fund, he is funded out of the general fund.

Councilor Rivera: Would that include the Chief of Staff as well? Can we get a listing of the total cost, titles, departments and salaries?

Brad Fluetsch: Yes.

Ms. McCoy said she can provide the list with the total cost of the increase and identify where that will come from.

Councilor Lindell: Timing on memo from the City Manager on fee waivers? City Manager isn't here to request this and asked about the timing of this.

Chair Abeyta said that he asked for this information.

Councilor Harris: Will have follow up on PSA use.

Councilor Rivera: Fee waivers, partial fee waivers we requested? Can you F/U with those who have been given partials? Do we have a list of those who haven't paid their partial fees?

9. MATTERS FROM THE COMMITTEE

Councilor Romero-Wirth: Subject of police raises, we have had hear in the press the difference from what our officers make and difference from ABQ, if we wanted to do raises in Santa Fe what would it cost the city at various levels? What does that number look like if we were to be competitive with Albuquerque?

Councilor Harris: MOA – between city and Northern NM Airport Alliance, can you track it and get it moving. Councilor Harris did mark ups on it.

Mary McCoy: Is it for the current or previous year?

Councilor Harris: I believe it is the current year, I looked at the scope; they have been operating without an MOA.

This came up in Public Works, Mr. Chapman, the Grants Administrator, housekeeping to do with DFA and about 5 grants. I talked a lot about an \$855,000 grant for the terminal at the airport; this would be a legislative appropriated grant agreement 16-82510. It seems like there might be a balance available to the tune of \$530,000 for the terminal and I would really like to know a status. This particular grant has a reversion in 2020; can you check to see if this is available?

Chair Abeyta: F/U – Answer on the airport property if an appraisal needs to be done. It might be complicate on payment of rates.

10. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Finance Committee, the Chair called for adjournment at 6:30 pm.
