the *city's* records for not less than fifty years. *Permit* copies or summary records for secondary construction *permits* such as plumbing, mechanical and electrical *permits* shall be retained for not less than ten years.

(5) Posting of Construction Permits

Within twenty-four hours after issuance of a construction permit, the applicant shall post the property for which the permit has been issued with posters obtained from the land use director. One or more posters shall be prominently displayed, readable from each public and private road abutting the property, and securely placed on the property. If the property does not abut a public street or road, the land director [may] shall require additional posters within nearby public streets or roads to provide effective notice public. Placement of the posters shall be in such a manner as not to compromise public safety. The posters shall remain in place until after the completion and final inspection of all work covered by the permit.

(6) Compliance with Permit Requirements

No construction or other *development* for which a *permit* is required shall be done prior to obtaining the *permit*. All work shall comply with the provisions of the approved *permit*.

(7) Combined Permits

The *land use director* may require separate construction *permits* for each of the categories of *development* identified in this section or may issue a combined construction *permit* for two or more of the categories.
