17	Section 1. A new Section 12-1-16.1 of the Uniform Traffic Ordinance (being
18	Ord. #2006-34, as amended) is ordained to read:
19	12-1-22.1 ELECTRIC SCOOTER.
20	"Electric scooter" means an electric vehicle consisting of a narrow footboard mounted
21	between two wheels in tandem with an upright steering handle attached to the front wheel that is
22	propelled via electricity.
23	Section 2. A new Section 12-8-18 of the Uniform Traffic Ordinance (being Ord.
24	#2006-34, as amended) is ordained to read:
25	12-8-18 ELECTRIC SCOOTERS PROHIBITED.

Electric scooters that are available to rent via dockless or docked rental systems are prohibited from using public streets, sidewalks, parks, or any other public area unless the Governing Body approves the implementation of up to a two-year pilot program via Resolution. As of March of 2019, the residents of the City of Santa Fe have not experienced access to a company that provides on-demand electric scooters to rent. However, there have been many references in social media, news outlets, and other means of communication that on-demand rentable electric scooters may be coming to the community. The City does not see a "major" positive or negative effect on the community other than the costs potentially lost by local entrepreneurs being part of a scooter company and the potential health and safety considerations that could result if a electric scooter company provided services that were not developed in a manner that enhanced user safety to the extent practicable.
