A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER DURING VELO NEW MEXICO'S SANTA FE MOUNTAIN FEST ON SEPTEMBER 13-14, 2019, PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-6.2(B) SFCC 1987.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2017-3 on March 8, 2017 that created a new process for approving the sale and consumption of alcohol on city property; and

WHEREAS, for locations not specifically mentioned in Section 23-6.2(A) SFCC 1987, the approval by the Governing Body of a resolution that specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, and required permits is required 60 days prior to the event; and

WHEREAS, Velo New Mexico desires to hold this year's Santa Fe Mountain Fcst at the Santa Fe Railyard Park; and

WHEREAS, the Railyard Park is a City of Santa Fe Park at which Alcohol is not usually served; and

WHEREAS, alcohol service provided by Santa Fe Brewing Co., Second Street Brewery,


1 and Canteen Brewing would adhere to all regulations in Section 23-6.3 SFCC 1987; and

2 **WHEREAS**, Velo New Mexico's Santa Fe Mountain Fest hopes to attract an increasing
3 number of out-of-city active travelers to promote Santa Fe as an outdoor recreation destination.

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
5 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that alcohol service during Velo New Mexico's Santa Fe Mountain Fest is
6 hereby approved, contingent upon an amendment to SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2(B), permitting
7 approval by resolution thirty (30) days rather than sixty (60) days in advance of the event.




