AN ORDINANCE
RELATING TO THE CITY OF SANTA FE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN
ORDINANCE, ARTICLE 11-11 SFCC 1987; APPROVING AND ADOPTING A LOCAL
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SANTA FE AND SAVANT X, INC. FOR DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT, AND
CONSTRUCTION OF TENANT IMPROVEMENTS; AND FOR LEASE PAYMENTS TO
EXPAND A CORPORATE RESEARCH CENTER, A LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
PROJECT.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Savant X Local Economic
Development Project Ordinance."
Section 2. Recitals.
A. The Local Economic Development Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 5-10-1 et seq.
("LEDA") explicitly permits municipalities to assist qualifying entities with economic development
projects through the use of public resources; and

B. The City of Santa Fe has complied with the requirements of the Local Economic Development Act by adopting an Economic Development Fund Ordinance (11-14 SFCC 1987), incorporating within that ordinance its community economic development plan and its economic development strategy for implementation dated May 21, 2008; and

C. Savant X, Inc., ("Qualifying Entity") is a software development research center that serves the public by stimulating and catalyzing the growth of a high-technology industry cluster in Santa Fe, which meets the definition of Qualifying Entity under the Economic Development Ordinance, Section 11-14.4(A) SFCC 1987); and the LEDA, NMSA 1978, Section 5-10-3 (K). The Qualifying Entity creates economic base jobs as a software development facility by creating software for advanced data analytics that provide visualization and understanding of many types of data. The development of quantum computing tools scaled for commercial use will be the top priority of the center located in Santa Fe.

D. The State of New Mexico has appropriated Four Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$450,000.00) from the New Mexico LEDA Fund and the City of Santa Fe will provide Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) from the Local Economic Development Fund for the project to pay lease payments and to fund the project build out of the infrastructure and tenant improvements in the facility and its projected second facility expansion, which will occur in the fifth (5) year of operation. The facility is located at 504 Jose Street in Santa Fe, New Mexico. The expansion may include construction costs, materials associated with the interior renovation of its facilities, and improvements or construction of telecommunications, broad band connectivity, and other infrastructure necessary to improve service to the facility. This project identified as the "Project" is a research center that will expand the tax base and generate more taxes, fees, and other revenues for the State of New Mexico and City of Santa Fe.

E. The facility will be used to develop software, which causes the company to fall under the definition of a "manufacturer" under LEDA.

5	B. In cor	mpliance with the City's Economic Development Fund Ordinance, 11-14 SFCC
6	(1987), this Project Pa	rticipation Agreement between Qualifying Entity and the City clearly states the
7	following:	
8	(1)	Savant X, Inc. is a qualifying entity;
9	(2)	The contributions of the City, the City as a fiscal agent of the State, and
10	Qualifying Em	tity;
11	(3)	The specific measurable objectives upon which the performance review will
12	be based;	
13	(4)	A schedule for Project development and goal attainment;
14	(5)	The security being offered for the City's investment;
15	(6)	The procedures by which the Project may be terminated and the City's
16	investment reco	overed;
17	(7)	The time period for which the City shall retain an interest in the Project;
18	(8)	The economic development goals of the project; and
19	(9)	A "sunset" clause after which the City shall relinquish interest in and oversight
20	of the project.	
21	Section 4.	Approval and Adoption of the Project Participation Agreement. The
22	go verning body hereby	approves the 2020 PPA (attached as Exhibit A) whereby the City will be the
23	Fiscal Agent for the Sta	ate legislative appropriation of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No
24	Cents (\$450,000.00) and	will designate the Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) in City
25	Funds. The City will pas	ss through the State Legislative appropriation of \$450,000.00 and provide the

1	City funds of \$50,000.00 to the Qualifying Entity and the funds will be used for lease payments,
2	infrastructure and tenant improvements for the facility, and the Qualifying Entity's projected second
3	facility expansion in the fifth (5) year of operation. The Qualifying Entity will expand the tax base and
4	generate more taxes, fees, and other revenues for the State of New Mexico and City of Santa Fe.
5	Section 5. Severability Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this
6	ordinance, or any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of any regulation promulgated hereunder
7	shall for any reason be held to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, the invalidity, illegality, or
8	unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect the validity of the
9	remaining portions of this ordinance or the regulation so challenged.
10	Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
11	adoption.
