19	Transportation Plan (MTP) identifies a future connection of Jaguar Drive to NM599; and
20	WHEREAS, the Tierra Contenta Master Plan also identifies a future connection of
21	Jaguar Drive to NM599; and
22	WHEREAS, right-of-way was reserved and environmentally cleared during the NM599
23	construction project for an interchange at this location; and
24	WHEREAS, a future interchange at this location will provide improved access to Tierra
25	Contenta and the Santa Fe Municipal Airport.

CITY OF SANTA FE staff is directed to: 1. Apply for an access break along NM 599 for the future Jaguar Drive interchange from the New Mexico Department of Transportation's (NMDOT) Access Control Committee; and 2. Pursue an airspace agreement with the NMDOT to allow for a city road (i.e. Jaguar Drive) to cross NMDOT owned right-of-way. PASSED, APPROVED, and ADOPTED this 10th day of November, 2009.
