The final interest rates and the final payment schedule, as set forth in this Second Supplemental Resolution, will be included in a supplement to Exhibit B of the Loan Agreement. The Authorized Officers of the Governmental Unit are hereby authorized to take all action necessary to incorporate the final interest rates and the final payment schedule into the Loan Agreement by attaching a supplement to Exhibit B of the Loan Agreement which includes such information and, if necessary, executing and delivering an amendment to Loan Agreement to make conforming changes.

Section 3. <u>Parameters Satisfied</u>. All terms and conditions relating to the Loan Agreement set forth in this Second Supplemental Resolution are within the parameters established by the First Supplemental Resolution and the Parameters Ordinance.

- A. The final net effective interest rate on the Loan Agreement is 5.73%. Such amount does not exceed the maximum rate of 12% per annum permitted under the First Supplemental Resolution and the Parameters Ordinance.
- B. The date of the approval of this Second Supplemental Resolution, September 30, 2009, is prior to the date which the NMFA will close its bond transaction securing permanent financing for the Loan Agreement as required in the First Supplemental Resolution.
