11	DECLARING SUPPORT FOR PASSAGE OF LOCAL FINANCING AND ECONOMIC
12	DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS THAT ALLOW PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS.
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14	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is a home rule municipality under applicable
15	provisions of the New Mexico Constitution and State Statutes; and
16	WHEREAS, consistent to and pursuant to its authority under state law, the City of Santa
17	Fe has issued industrial revenue bonds to encourage and promote business and economic
18	development opportunities; and
19	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has successfully developed the Railyard property and
20	wishes to have the Railyard fully built out; and
21	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has supported in the past, legislative efforts led by
22	Speaker of the House Ben Lujan to pass legislation that would provide municipalities and local
23	governments with additional public financing mechanisms that would benefit economic
24	development partnerships with private entities; and
25	WHEREAS, there has occurred historic financial events in our nation and our State that

1 require different approaches to encourage, promote and develop economic development 2 opportunities in our community; and 3 WHEREAS, passage of legislation by the State Legislature that attempts to give 4 additional public-private financing mechanisms to local governments will spur economic and 5 financial activity within Santa Fe. 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE 7 CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body hereby declares that it supports as many legal 8 mechanisms that will encourage, promote, develop and foster economic development 9 relationships with private industry; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the efforts of Speaker of House Ben Lujan to 11 amend state law to allow for local public-private financing options are commended; and 12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City legislative/lobbying efforts shall be 13 engaged to support and promote any and all attempts to give the City additional local financing 14 tools to encourage, promote, develop and foster economic development relationships with private 15 industry; and 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that our State legislative delegation is petitioned to 17 actively support and promote legislation that will give the City additional local financing tools to 18 encourage, promote, develop and foster economic development relationships with private 19 industry; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon passage, the City Clerk shall deliver this 21 Resolution to the Governor's office and to each of the City's state legislative delegation.
