10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **DIRECTING STAFF TO CONDUCT THE NECESSARY TRAFFIC STUDY TO DETERMINE**
12 **IF MID-BLOCK CROSSWALKS ARE APPROPRIATE ON CALLE ATAJO AND IF SO,**
13 **DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE FUNDING AND INSTALL THE CROSSWALKS AS PER**
14 **TRAFFIC ENGINEERING STANDARDS.**

16 **WHEREAS,** Las Acequias is a family neighborhood on the city's southwest side
17 consisting of 550 houses located between Airport Road and Agua Fria Street; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Las Acequias Neighborhood recently petitioned the Governing Body
19 for assistance in making their neighborhood a safer place; and

20 **WHEREAS,** in particular, the neighborhood stressed the need to provide safe pedestrian
21 access to Las Acequias Park located on Calle Atajo; and

22 **WHEREAS,** according to Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) guidelines and
23 criteria, the City may designate and maintain mid-block cross walks by appropriate devices,
24 markings or lines on the surface of the street where certain FHWA criteria are met.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**


1 CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to conduct the necessary traffic study to determine if

3 and install the crosswalks as per traffic engineering standards.


