14	WHO RECENTLY WERE KILLED IN A VEHICULAR ACCIDENT; AND TO
15	COLLABORATE WITH THE YOUTH, FORMER MEMBERS OF THE CUARTO
16	CENTENARIO CATHEDRAL PARK MONUMENT COMMITTEE AND NON-PROFIT
17	ORGANIZATIONS TO IDENTIFY A LOCATION AND CREATE POLICIES FOR A
18	PERMANENT MEMORIAL TO HONOR ALL SANTA FE YOUTH WHO HAVE DIED.

20	WHEREAS, early on the morning of Sunday June 28, 2009, four Santa Fe youth ages 15
21	to 17 were killed tragically in a head-on collision on Old Las Vegas Highway; and
22	WHEREAS, those mourning the sudden and needless loss of these four youth have
23	created a makeshift shrine on and around the "Settlers Monument" located in Cathedral Park; and
24	WHEREAS, the monument, erected in 2003 by the Cuarto Centenario Cathedral Park
25	Monument Committee, marks the 400 th anniversary of the arrival in New Mexico of Europeans

and signifies our forefathers continuing contribution to the history, culture and values of today's America; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, former members of the Cuarto Centenario Cathedral Park Monument Committee and the Santa Fe community support those who mourn and wish to recognize and honor those whose lives are cut short; and

WHEREAS, participants in creating the makeshift shrine have asked that they be involved in relocating the temporary shrine and have agreed to assist the City in cleaning up the statue and Cathedral Park.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes that the youth are the future leaders of our community and recognizes the valuable experience and knowledge of our older community members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to collaborate with the youth to identify an alternative, temporary location for the memorial currently at Cathedral Park honoring the four youth who recently were killed in a vehicular accident; and to collaborate with the youth, former members of the Cuarto Centenario Cathedral Park Monument Committee and non-profit organizations to identify a location and create policies for a permanent memorial to honor all Santa Fe youth who have died.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body directs staff to coordinate outreach and educational opportunities so that community members may pass on to our youth the importance of maintaining historical and cultural significance in our community.
