A RESOLUTION

**DIRECTING STAFF TO APPLY FOR A 6 MONTH EXTENSION TO AN EXISTING
MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEW
MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF SANTA FE
FOR THE OLD PECOS TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – CORDOVA ROAD
TO BERGER STREET.**

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe and the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) are currently involved in a Municipal Arterial Program (MAP) Agreement providing \$200,000 for the Old Pecos Trail Reconstruction project from Cordova Road to Berger Street comprised of \$150,000 in NMDOT funding with a City match of \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the MAP agreement is set to expire on June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City has limited the scope of the project, pertaining to the MAP Agreement, to the widening of Old Pecos Trail in front of the Children's Museum to provide median refuge; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to complete construction of these improvements by

1 December 31, 2009.


2 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
