11 **AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF WATER GENERATED FROM PAST**  
12 **CITY CONSERVATION INITIATIVE TO THE CITY'S AFFORDABLE**  
13 **HOUSING CREDIT POOL.**

15 **WHEREAS**, the City has used conserved water to create an affordable housing credit  
16 pool, which is now depleted; and


17 **WHEREAS**, the City plans to maintain its policy to provide water for affordable  
18 housing; and

19 **WHEREAS**, since August 2003, the City has issued 2,000 rebates for high efficiency  
20 washing machines that were installed within the City limits, and which the Water Division  
21 estimates have resulted in 49.7 acre-feet of conserved water.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
23 **CITY OF SANTA FE, MEXICO:** The City's shall allocate to the affordable housing credit  
24 pool 49.7 acre-feet of conserved water resulting from the City's washing machine rebate  
25 program.




