10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **IN SUPPORT OF THE RODEO ROAD MEDIAN LANDSCAPING PROJECT FUNDED**
12 **FROM THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 THROUGH A**
13 **COOPERATIVE PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF**
14 **TRANSPORTATION.**

16 **WHEREAS**, funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009,
17 (Pub. L. 111-5) appropriated by the United States Congress, signed into law on February 17, 2009
18 and apportioned on March 2, 2009, are available to local governments through the Federal Surface
19 Transportation Program administered by the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT);


21 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the City of Santa Fe to enter into a cooperative project
22 agreement with the NMDOT to receive ARRA funding in the amount of \$150,000 for the Rodeo
23 Road Median Landscaping Project.

24 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
25 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body supports the Rodeo Road Median Landscaping

1 Project funded in the amount of \$150,000 from the American Recovery and Reinvestments Act of
2 2009, supports approval a cooperative project agreement with the NMDOT to receive ARRA funding,
3 and further certifies that this federal funding is an appropriate use of tax payer dollars.


4 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Santa Fe shall accept responsibility
5 for the project; assumes the lead role in design development and construction of the project; agrees to
6 the terms, conditions, and certification and reporting requirements of the cooperative project
7 agreement; and assumes ownership, liability and maintenance responsibilities for all amenities related
8 to the completion of the project.


