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10	A RESOLUTION
11	APPROVING THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PLAN FOR THE 400 <sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY
12	BANNERS.
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14	WHEREAS, on December 10, 2008, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance 2008-56
15	that amended Section 14-8.10 SFCC 1987 (sign code) in order to authorize banners
16	commemorating the 400 year anniversary of the founding of La Villa Real de la Santa Fe de San
17	Francisco de Asis; and
18	WHEREAS, such Ordinance requires the Governing Body to adopt a resolution
19	regarding the banners providing for such specifics as dates, location, number, design approval
20	process, installation and maintenance; and
21	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe 400 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee has spent the last five months
22	counting light poles, reviewing maps, working with various designer and researching the most
23	durable hardware and installation material; and
24	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe 400 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee has submitted their design and
25	installation plan for the 400 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary banners for review and recommendation by the

1	Historic Design Review Board and for final approval by the Governing Body; and
2	WHEREAS, on May 12, 2009 the Historic Design Review Board recommended
3	approval of the banners with the following conditions: there be no more than 1500 banners total;
4	the maximum size of banners within the historic districts be 4 ft. x 2 ft.; the phrase "proud
5	sponsor" be deleted; the sponsor logo size be further limited in order to emphasize the 400 <sup>th</sup>
6	information; and that all banners and attachment fittings be removed with 45 days after the final
7	event.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
9	CITY OF SANTA FE that the design and installation plan for the 400 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary banners
10	attached is approved with the conditions recommended by the Historic Design Review Board.
11	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition of approval, the 400 <sup>th</sup>
12	anniversary committee shall obtain:
13	a) Necessary approvals to install on the light poles;
14	b) Permit to obstruct the street from the public works department;
15	c) Provide a surety to the city in a form acceptable to the city attorney in the event
16	that the banners are not removed; and
17	d) Provide a release of liability in a form acceptable to the city attorney.
18	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is directed to provide information
19	regarding the city sign code to businesses that produce signs and banners as well as to the general
20	public.
