16	Section 1.	Section 14-8.3(C)(2) SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2001-38, §2 as amended)				
17	is amended to read:					
18	(2)	No new development or substantial improvements shall be undertaken on				
19		lands within a special flood hazard area unless such erection or alteration				
20		shall be in compliance with the provisions of this section, provided that a				
21		legal nonconforming structure in existence on, 2009				
22		(date of adoption of this Ordinance) located within a special flood hazard				
23		area that is substantially damaged by flood, fire, or other casualty may be				
24		replaced subject to the following:				
25		(a) If there is a site on the property outside the special flood hazard				

1	1	area that will accommodate a structure of the same gross floor
2		area as the legal nonconforming structure, the structure shall be
3		built on such site and not replaced within the special flood
4		hazard area.
5	<u>(b)</u>	If the legal nonconforming structure was located within the flood
6		fringe, and there is no other site on the property that will
7		accommodate a structure of the same gross floor area, a new
8		structure may be constructed on such site in the flood fringe
9		provided that the new structure does not exceed the gross floor
10		area nor the footprint of the legal nonconforming structure and
11		the footprint is sized to minimize flood hazard.
12	<u>(c)</u>	If the legal nonconforming structure was located in the floodway
13		but there is a site on the property within the flood fringe that will
14		accommodate a structure of the same gross floor areas as the
15		legal nonconforming structure, any new structure shall be
16		constructed on such site within the flood fringe and not replaced
17		within the floodway. The footprint of the new structure shall be
18		sized to minimize flood hazard and shall in no case exceed the
19		footprint of the legal nonconforming structure.
20	<u>(d)</u>	If the legal nonconforming structure was located within the
21		floodway, and there is no other site on the property that will
22		accommodate a structure of the same gross floor area, a new
23		structure may be constructed on such site in the floodway
24		provided that the new structure does not exceed the gross floor
25		area nor the footprint of the legal nonconforming structure and
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1			the footprint is sized to minimize flood hazard.	
2		<u>(e)</u>	Any new structure constructed within the special flood hazard	
3			area in accordance with this paragraph (2) shall comply with all	
4			applicable FEMA requirements and all provisions of §14-8.3 that	
5			are more stringent than the FEMA requirements.	
6		<u>(f)</u>	A new structure built in accordance with this paragraph (2) shall	
7			not require a variance to be constructed in a special flood hazard	
8			area; provided that, if the new structure's location requires	
9			variances to other requirements of this Chapter, the Board of	
10			Adjustment, Planning Commission or other review body, as	
11			applicable, grants a variance from such other requirements	
12			including, but not limited to, setbacks and terrain management.	
13		(g)	As a condition of building permit issuance for a new structure,	
14			any remaining legal nonconforming structure in the flood hazard	
15			area shall be demolished or removed.

18	(3)	No use	es shall be permitted within the floodway, except those set out in	
19		this paragraph provided that [the] such uses do not constrict the flow or		
20		[reduc	e the carrying capacity] create a rise in the base flood elevation	
21		during the one percent chance event, as follows:		
22		(a)	Cultivating and harvesting of crops according to recognized soil	
23			conservation practices;	
24		(b)	Pasture, grazing land and outdoor plant nursery;	
25		(c)	Wildlife sanctuary, woodland preserve, arboretum;	
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1		(d)	Outlet installations for sewage treatment plants, sealed public
2			water supply wells;
3		(e)	Passive recreational uses such as parks, picnic areas or trails;
4		(f)	Open area residential uses, such as lawns, gardens and play
5			areas; [and]
6		(g)	Stormwater management and arroyo or watercourse stabilization
7			structures, such as check dams and gabions, if these structures

11			on, 2009 (date of adoption of this Ordinance),
12			provided that such uses may not be intensified and that the
13			structures which such uses occupy comply with all applicable
14			FEMA requirements and all provisions of §14-8.3 that are more
15			stringent than the FEMA requirements.

18		(e)	Except as permitted in paragraph (5) of this section, if an
19			existing lot contains land both within and outside of the special
20			flood hazard area, any new construction, including roads and
21			driveways, shall only occur on the portion outside of the special
22			flood hazard area. If an existing lot contains no land outside of
23			the special flood hazard area, any new construction, including
24			roads and driveways shall only occur in the flood fringe upon
25			approval of a variance from the Planning Commission as set
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1	forth in §14-3.9(E) and shall conform to the provisions set forth
2	in paragraph (5), of this section. This paragraph (e) shall not
3	apply to legal nonconforming structures described in paragraph
4	(2) of this section;
