11 **A RESOLUTION**

12 **SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 582 THAT WOULD ENACT THE LOCAL HISPANO**
13 **ARTS AND CRAFTS SALES ACT.**

14 **WHEREAS**, Senator Phil Griego has introduced Senate Bill 582 which, if passed, enacts
15 the Local Hispano Arts and Crafts Sales Act (the "Act"); and

16 **WHEREAS**, if adopted, the Act would establish requirements for the labeling of items as
17 authentic local Hispano arts and crafts, including tinwork, furniture, straw appliqué and
18 woven goods; and

19 **WHEREAS**, such goods would be required to be made from materials harvested or
20 produced in New Mexico and handmade by local Hispanos; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Act would make it illegal to barter, trade, sell or offer for sale or trade
22 any product represented as produced by local Hispanos unless the product is produced,
23 designed or created by the labor or workmanship of a local Hispano; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Act would require every person selling or offering for sale a product
25 that is represented to be authentic local Hispano arts and crafts to make due inquiry of the

1 person's suppliers concerning the true nature of the materials, product design and process of
2 manufacture to determine whether the product may be lawfully represented as authentic local
3 Hispano arts and crafts.

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
5 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body supports Senate Bill 582 that would enact the
6 Local Hispano Arts and Crafts Sales Act.




