25	benefit reductions will directly harm Santa Fe citizens, taxpayers, and the general fund of the

	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
	CITY OF SANTA FE that the City of Santa Fe urges the State of New Mexico to do everything
	in its power to avert layoffs and work collaboratively with cities, counties, public school districts,
	universities, and employee organizations to find ways to continue supporting existing services,
	employment, and benefits at least at their current levels, particularly PERA and ERA.

	Fe's Legislative Delegation, to the Governor and to the City's lobbyist.
