


1 amendment to New Mexico's laws for consideration by the Legislature at its next session which

6 the state of New Mexico to help protect family pets from dangerous environments.


7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**

12 PASSED, APPROVED, and ADOPTED this 28th day of January, 2009.


