10	A RESOLUTION
11	ENDORSING THE CONCEPTS INCLUDED IN THE "PLAN TO END
12	HOMELESSNESS IN FIVE YEARS" PRESENTED BY THE MAYOR'S BLUE RIBBON
13	PANEL TO END HOMELESSNESS.
14	
15	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is committed to affordable housing opportunities for
16	all of its citizens; and
17	WHEREAS, the Mayor's Blue Ribbon Panel to End Homelessness has prepared an
18	ambitious plan for ending homelessness in Santa Fe in five years; and
19	WHEREAS, the plan to end homelessness envisions an array of housing opportunities,
20	services, and shelters to assist homeless people; and
21	WHEREAS, the plan to end homelessness incorporates a housing first strategy which
22	has been shown to be successful in ending homelessness for most people; and
23	WHEREAS, the plan to end homelessness envisions housing formerly homeless people
24	in mixed income communities such as those pioneered by the Colorado Coalition for the
25	homeless; and

1	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has adopted the Housing Trust Fund Ordinance
2	(Article 26-3 SFCC 1987) that establishes a requirement for the Governing Body to identify
3	funding priorities every two years; and
4	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is preparing a community housing plan to address a
5	broad spectrum of housing needs and gaps in the market that will include the plans to end
6	homelessness; and
7	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe allocates funding for affordable housing initiatives
8	through a request for proposal; and
9	WHEREAS, the plan to end homelessness includes a plan for programs and
10	housing for homeless youth.
11	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has limited resources to support all requests for
12	funding to provide affordably priced homes for all Santa Feans.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
14	CITY OF SANTA FE that the concepts outlined in the "Plan to End Homelessness in Five
15	Years" presented by the Mayor's Blue Ribbon Panel to End Homelessness are endorsed and that
16	any project or program included in the Plan seeking city funding and/or support will be evaluated
17	within the context of all the housing and human services needs in the community.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is directed to allocate
19	\$20,000 from available General Fund cash reserves to Youth Shelters and Family
20	Services for a street outreach program within 30 days of adoption of this resolution.
