11	AMENDING SECTION 6-17.3 SFCC 1987 REGARDING MEMBERSHIP
12	REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BUSINESS AND QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE.

14	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
15	Section 1. Section 6-17.3 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2005-5, §4) is amended to
16	read:
17	6-17.3 Membership; Terms.
18	A. Membership. The city business and quality of life advisory committee shall be
19	composed of twelve (12) members residing in [the city] Santa Fe County and qualified by
20	training, experience, and ability to exercise sound and practical judgment regarding those powers
21	and duties of the committee. The members shall be appointed by the mayor with the advice and
22	consent of a majority vote of all the members of the governing body. The members shall include
23	two (2) [eity councilors] members of the governing body; the chairman or one (1) other member
24	of the economic development review committee established in subsection 11-11.6 SFCC 1987;
25	and nine (9) other members representing a broad range of business interests, including small and

1	large businesses, within the city including, but not limited to: arts and culture industries;
2	development, design, and construction; hospitality; technology; retail trade and services; and a
3	broad range of community interests, from organizations such as neighborhood associations or
4	related groups; preservation organizations; environmental organizations; open space
5	organizations; recreational organizations; and arts organizations. The [eity councilors] members
6	of the governing body shall serve as chairperson and vice chairperson as appointed by the mayor.
7	A quorum shall be at least seven members. Members shall serve without compensation.
8	B. Terms. Of the initial appointments, six (6) of the members shall be appointed for
9	one (1) year terms and six (6) shall be appointed for two (2) year terms. Subsequent terms shall
10	be for two (2) years to maintain staggering of terms. There shall be no limitation to the number of
11	consecutive terms a member may serve. Failing to attend three (3) consecutive regular meetings
12	or failing to attend thirty-three percent (33%) or more of the regular meetings in any year shall
13	constitute an automatic tender of resignation by such member, which the governing body may
14	accept or reject in its discretion. Vacancies, other than by expiration of terms, shall be filled for
15	the unexpired term in the same manner as original appointments.
