11 **AMENDING SECTION 23-5.3 F. (3) SFCC 1987 REGARDING CONDITIONS OF**
12 **OPERATION FOR PLAZA ARTISTS/ARTISANS RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF**
13 **ARTWORK.**



15 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:**

16 **Section 1. Section 23-5.3 F. (3) SFCC 1987 is amended to read:**

17 (3) All artists/artisans, except the portrait artist, shall occupy no more than
18 forty-two (42) square feet (seven feet by six feet (7'x 6')). The portrait artist shall occupy
19 no more than seventy (70) square feet (seven feet by ten feet (7' x 10')). Artists/Artisans
20 may have one (1) or two (2) display tables not to exceed a total of twenty-one (21) square
21 feet. Artists/artisans may have vertical displays not to exceed six (6') feet in height from
22 the ground. The artwork shall not be displayed more than six (6') feet from the ground. If
23 the jury panel approved two (2) art mediums, then the artist/artisan shall display each
24 medium equally during any one month but not necessarily simultaneously. The
25 artist/artisan shall not change the approved mediums during the term of the license. Each

1 table shall have skirting around three (3) sides. The side facing the Plaza Park may be left
2 open. An umbrella and up to two (2) chairs are permitted. In addition to the display
3 space, an additional work surface not to exceed four (4) square feet for operations may be
4 used provided it is not used for display. All other supplies and storage shall be kept in a
5 neat and orderly fashion within the vendor's space. The portrait artist may have one (1)
6 easel.
